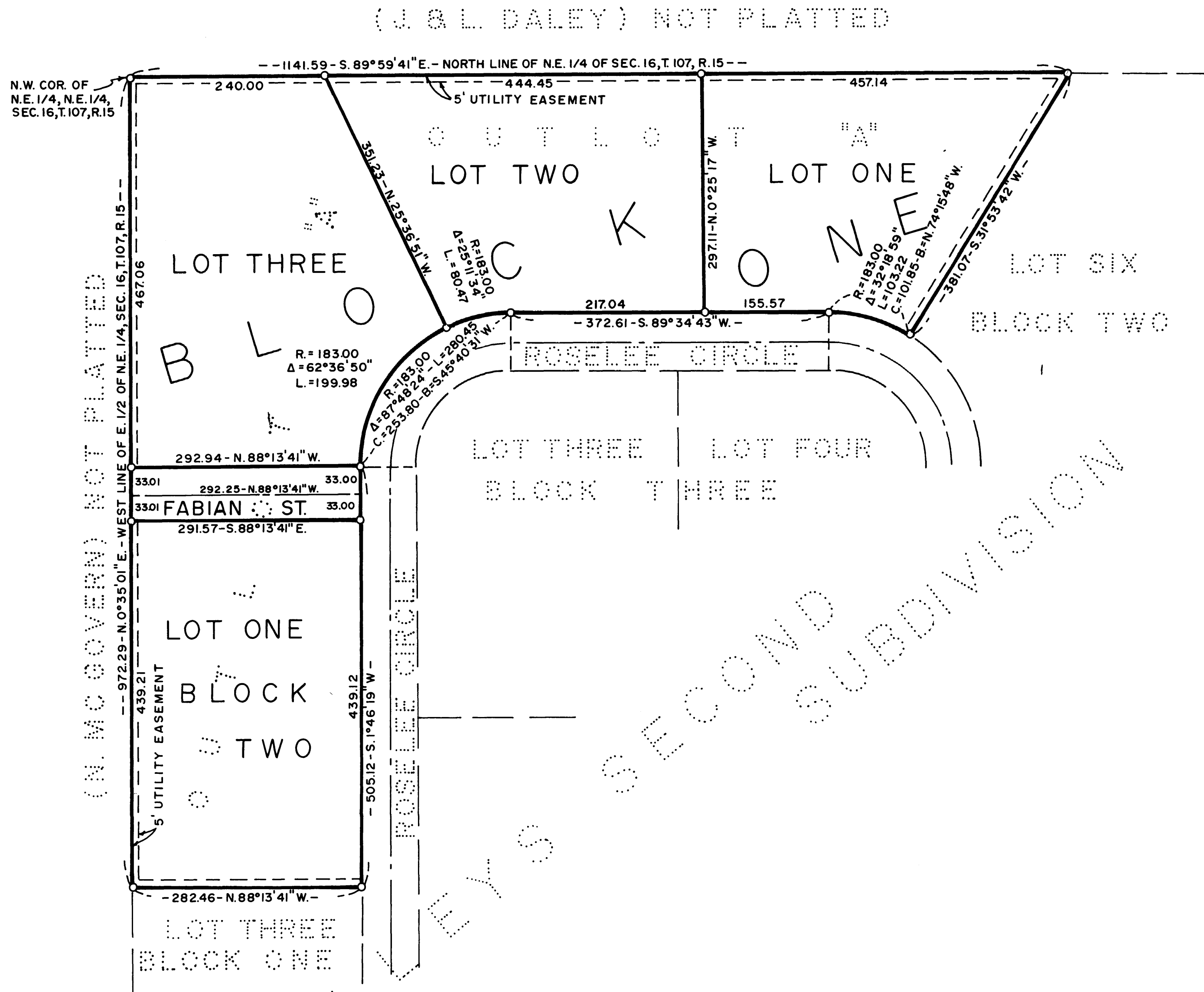

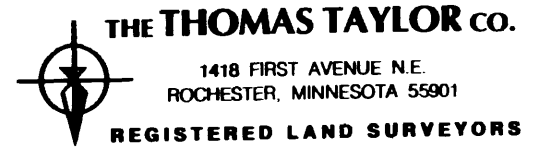


(N.M.C GOVERN) NOT PLATTED
