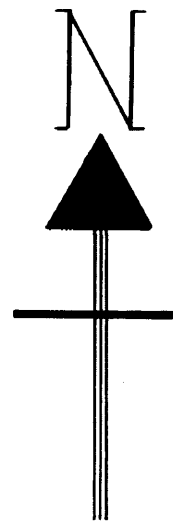
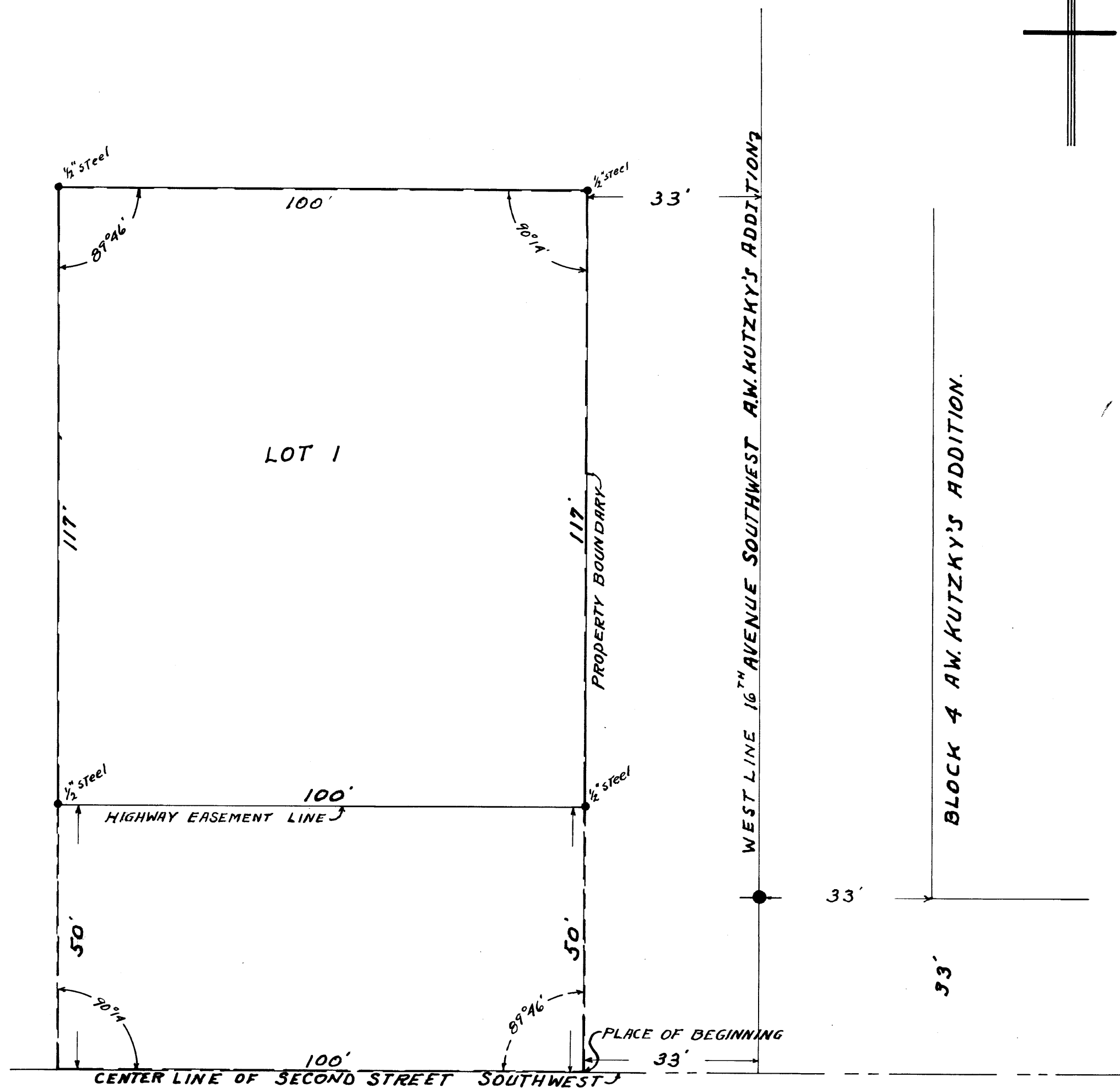


SCHLEIF'S ADDITION.
