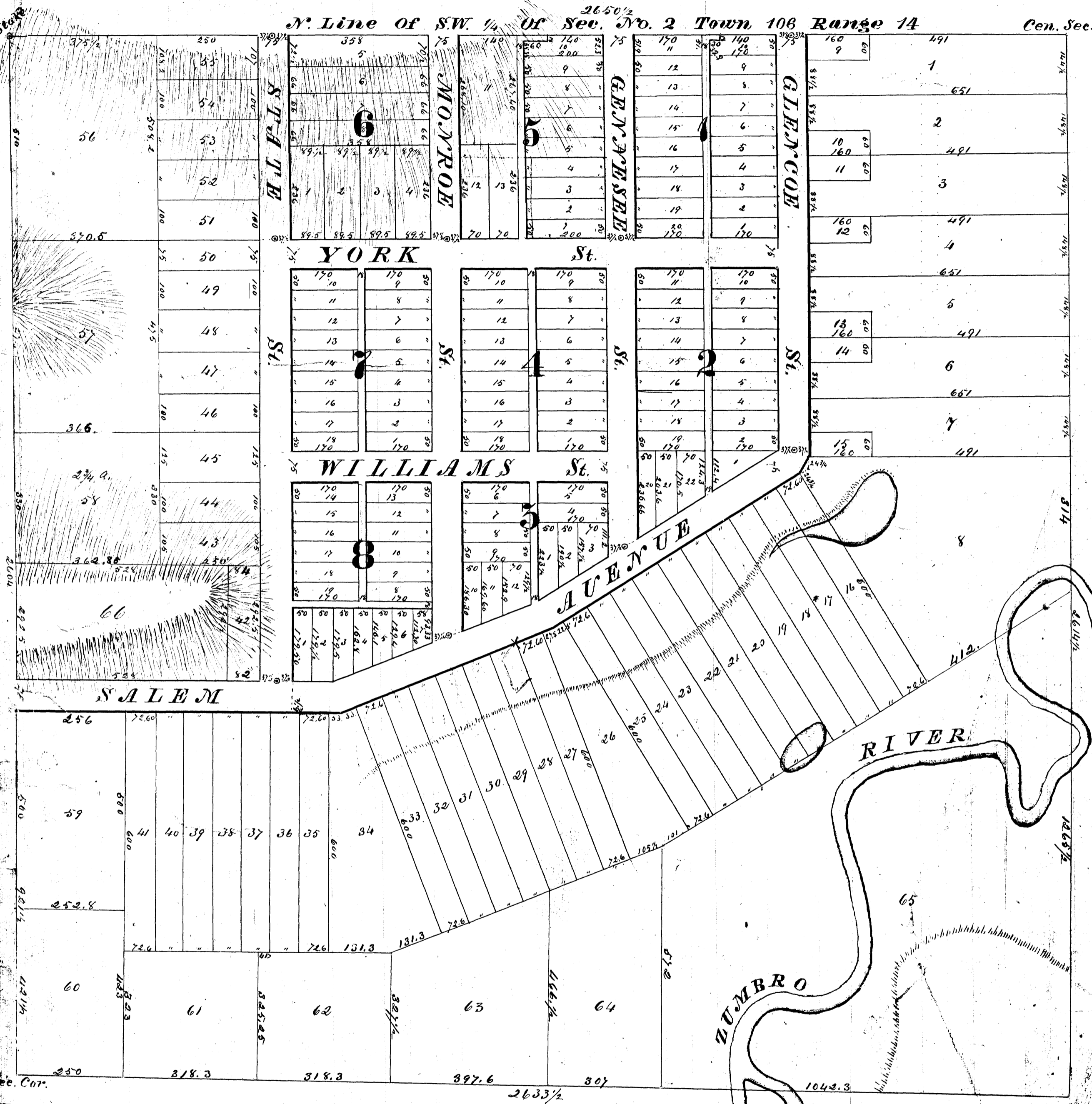


WILLIAMS' HEALY'S & CORNFORTH'S

ADDITION TO ROCHESTER.



Explanation

The accompanying plat of Williams' Healy's and Cornforth's Addition to Rochester embraces the whole of the South West quarter of Section number two, in Town 106 North, of Range 14 west in Olmsted County, Minnesota.

The streets and alleys are laid out parallel to or at right angles with the East line of said quarter except the Easterly portion of Salem Avenue which is as indicated on the plat.

All lots South and East of Salem Avenue and West of State Street are Odd Lots and are laid out at right angles with the streets or the Section line on which they lie except lots 56, 57 and 58, which are at right angles with State Street and lot 65 which is as indicated on the plat.

The widths of streets and alleys are expressed in figures in some portion of the same.

The number of blocks are expressed by larger figures near the center of the block, and of lots by smaller figures near the center of the lot. The size of lots are expressed by small figures on the margin of the lot except when marked thus "w" which indicates the size to be the same as the contiguous lot. Stone monuments are indicated thus.

Scale: 20 feet equals one inch.
