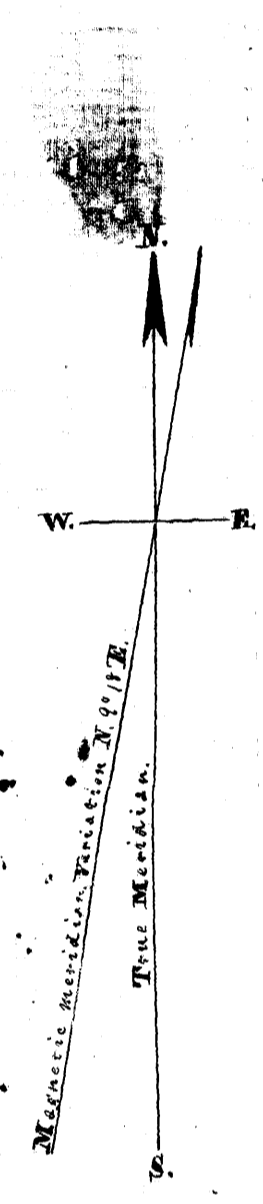
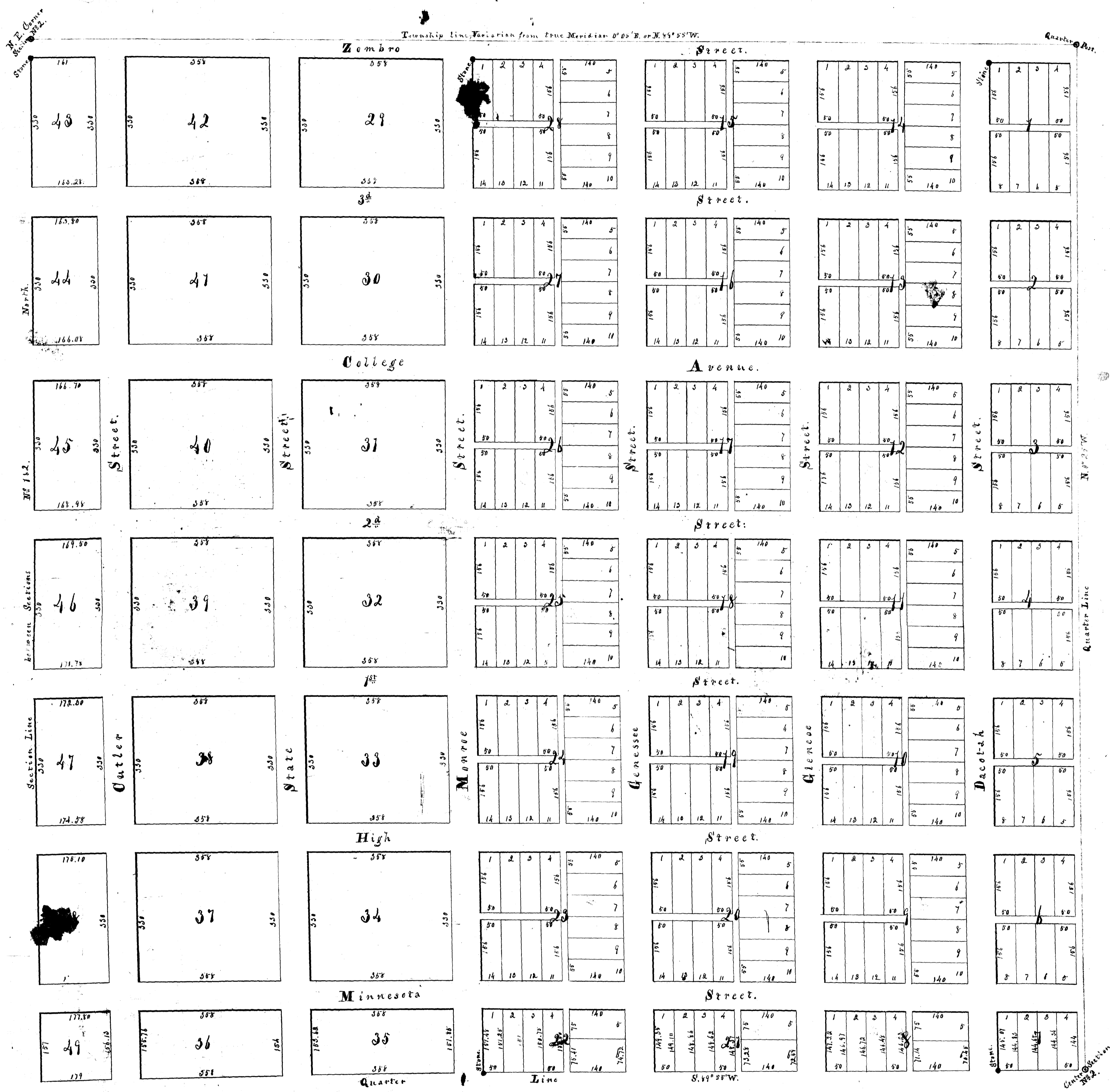


PLAN

HEAD and MAHON'S
ADDITION

Explanation - Head & Mahon's Addition to Rochester, comprises the North West Quarter of Section No. 22 in Township No. 42 North & Range No. 10 West of the 6th Principal Meridian - All East & West streets are laid parallel to the Township line, all North & South streets are laid parallel to the Quarter line of the above section, the beams of which lines are marked on the plat. The streets are all twenty-four feet wide, except College Avenue, which is thirty feet wide and Zembro street which is 24 feet wide. Alleys are eighteen feet wide. - Streets are numbered in black ink - lots are numbered in small figures in black ink, and their size in feet given in small figures in red ink - The position of stone are marked thus - on the plat.

I hereby certify the above, to be a true and correct plat of Head & Mahon's Addition to the Town of Rochester, in Ulster County, Minnesota as surveyed by me, between the 28th day of April and the 6th day of May, A.D. 1857.
