

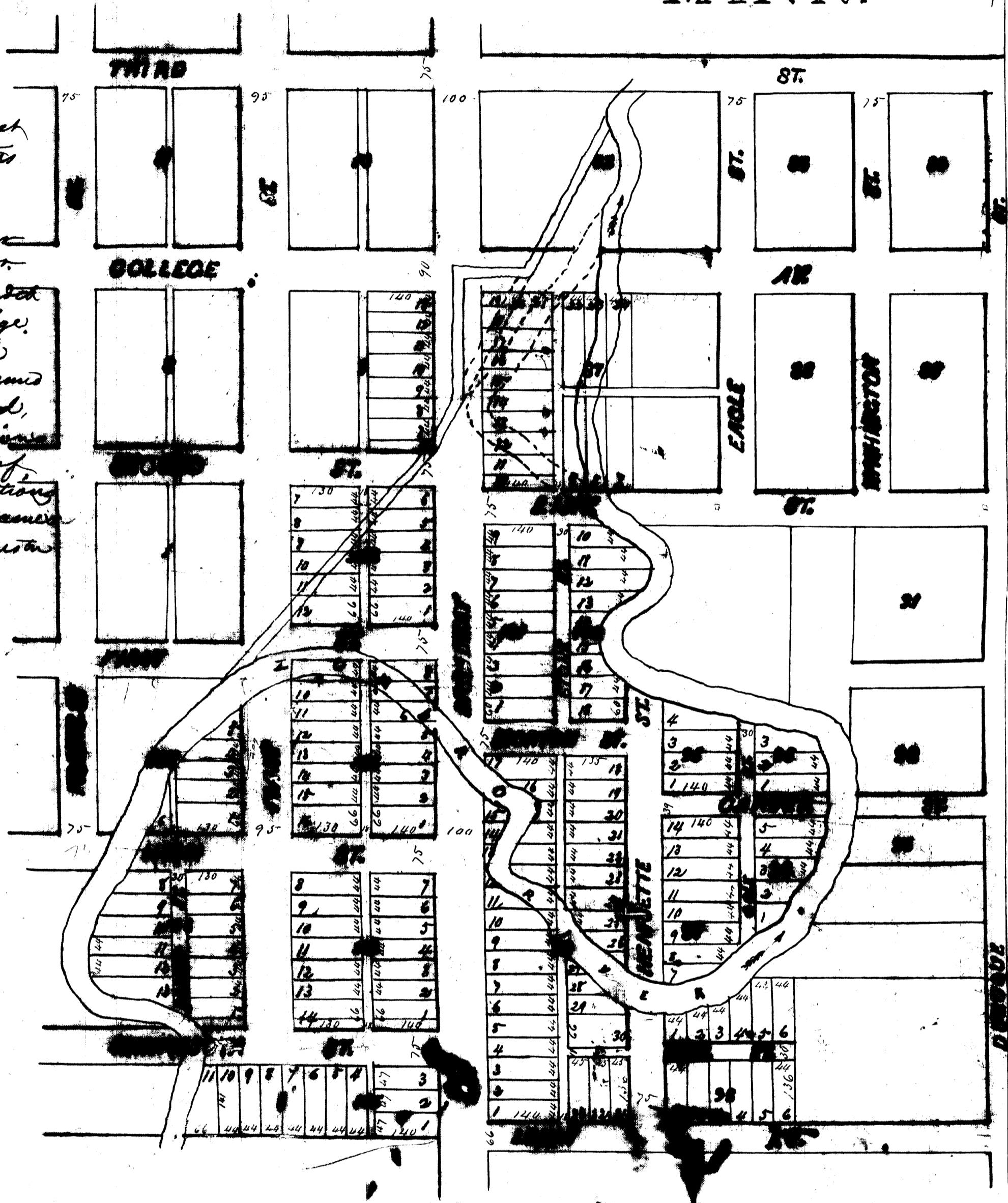
MAP OF WILLSON'S ADDITION

Explanations
 Fifty feet due North from the South West Corner of Block No. Eighty Seven (87) in this Addition is the initial point of the survey of this plat, which point is marked and designated by the corner Stone in the South West Corner of Dr. Kellys Brick Business House. The width of the streets and alleys and the size of the lots are as designated in red ink on said plat, and the streets named Broadway, Main, Line, First, Second, High & Minnesota are continuations of the streets in straight lines and of the same width & in the same direction with the streets bearing the same names in the portions of said city of Rochester heretofore surveyed and platted.
