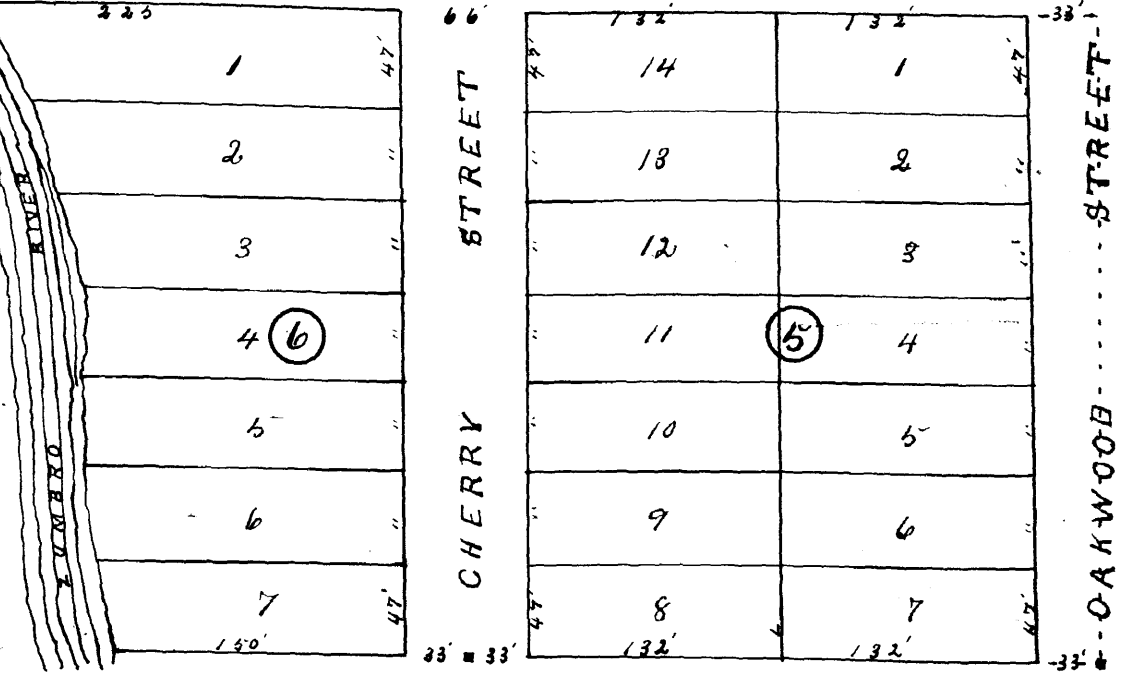

I Wm. Fraser County Surveyor in and for the County of Olmsted and State of Minnesota do hereby certify that I have made an examination of the ground of lots five (5) and six (6) State sub-division of School Section No thirty six. Town one hundred and seven north, Range Fourteen West, Olmsted County, Minnesota, described in the annexed Surveyor's Certificate and Plat, in compliance with an Act of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, and approved March 7th 1889, entitled "an Act to insure the accuracy of Town Plats", and that the monuments of the guidance of future surveys, as shown on the plat, have been correctly placed. That the boundary lines of the land plat are correctly shown on the plat, and that the size of the fractional lots indicated on the plat therein measurement given in feet.

That the within plat is a true representation of said survey and sub-division, particularly describing and setting forth streets and lots in said sub-division; giving the names, widths, courses, boundaries and extent of all such streets and the dimensions of all such lots. Streets are parallel with or perpendicular to the lot lines.
