

SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE

I Thomas Fraser surveyor in and for the County of Olmsted and State of Minnesota do hereby certify that I have made an examination on the ground of that part of the south west 1/4 of the north east 1/4 of section 34, Town 105 North, Range 14 West of the 5th principal Meridian, in compliance with the Act of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota and approved March 24th A.D. 1859. Entitled "An Act to Insure the Accuracy of Town Plats;

And that the monuments for the guidance of future surveys as shown on the Plat, have been correctly placed; that the boundary lines of the land platted are correctly shown on the plat; and that the size of the fractional lots are as shown on the plat herein.

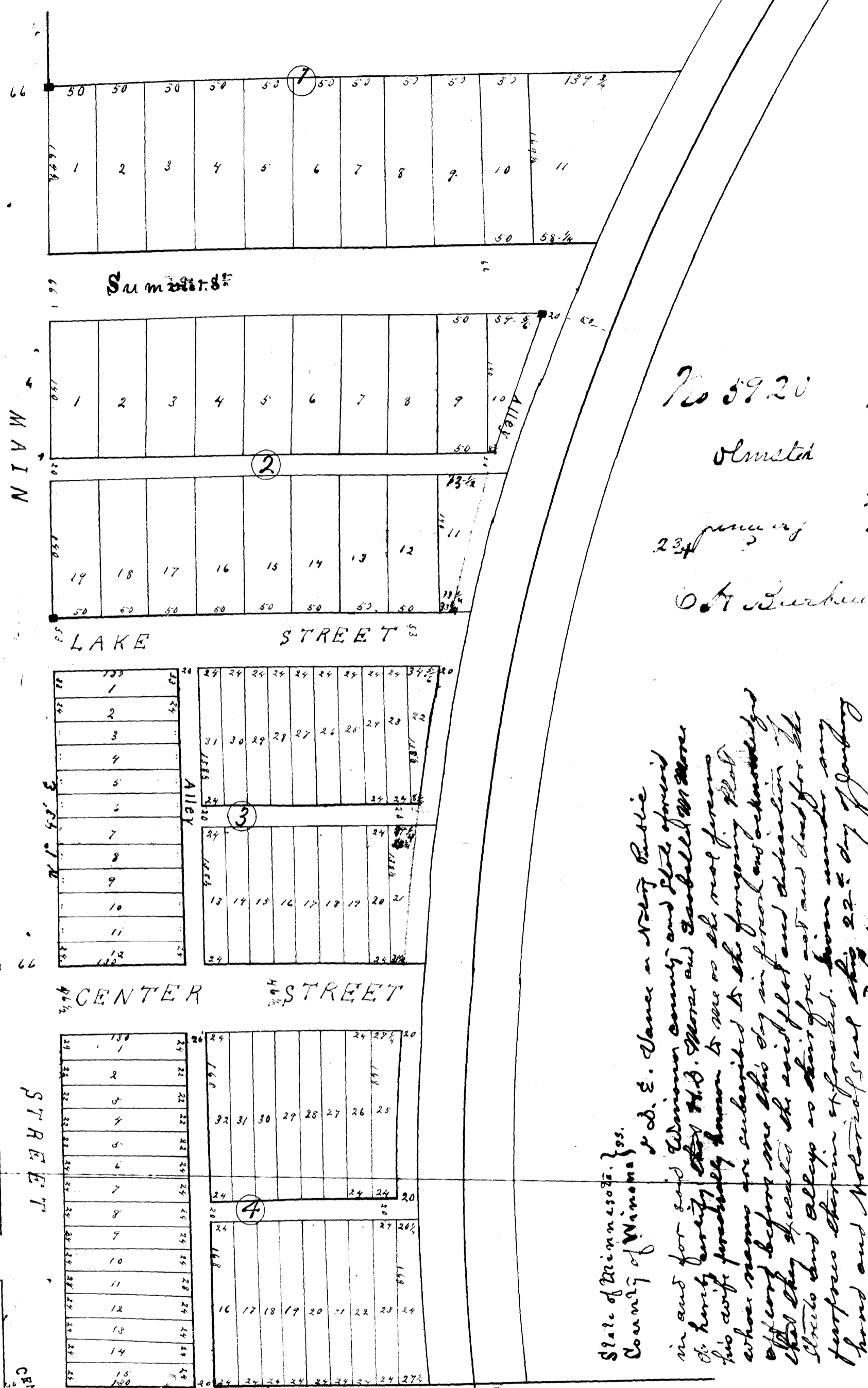

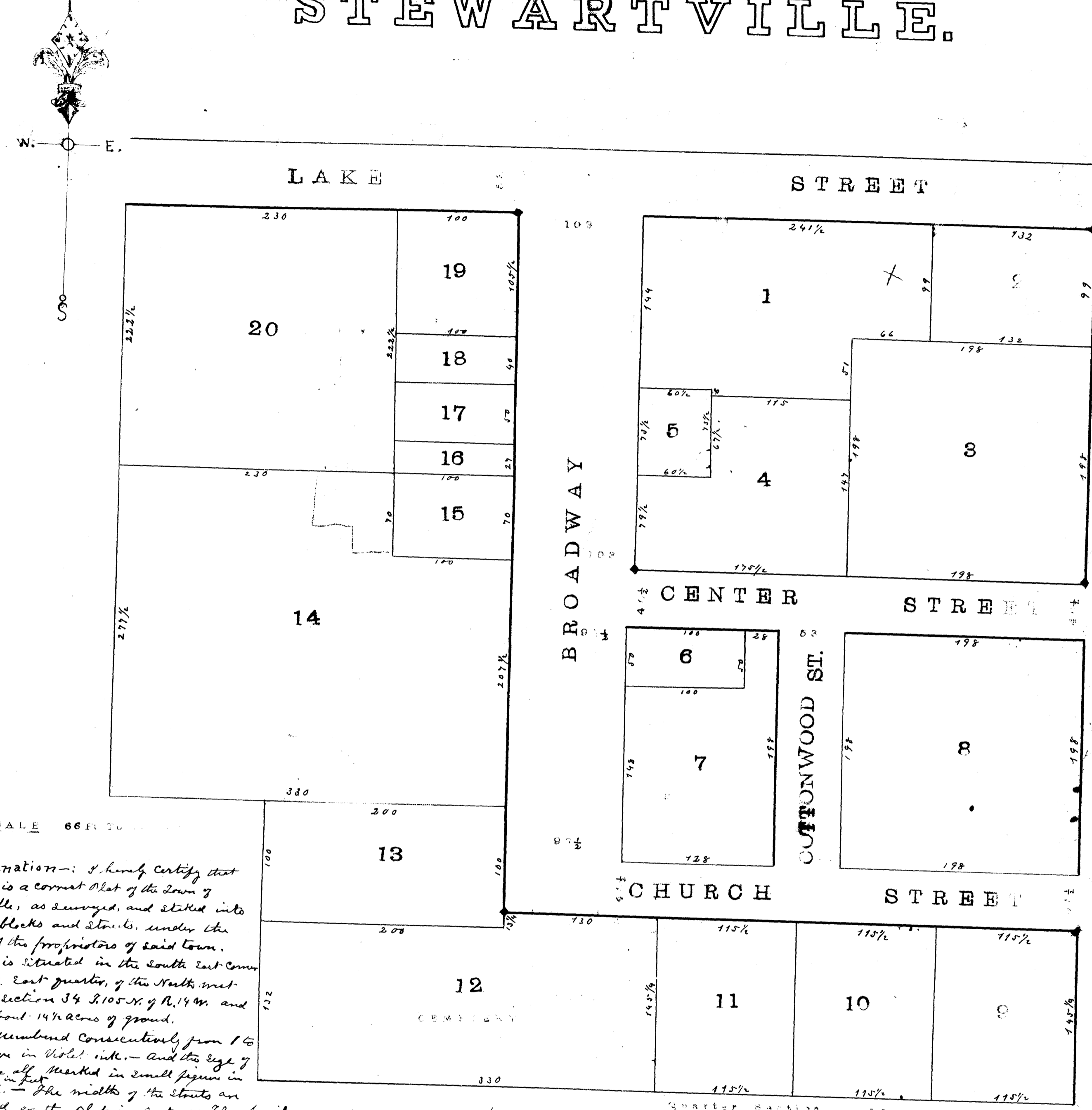

Explanation: I hereby certify that the above is a correct Plat of the town of Stewartville, as surveyed, and staked into lots and blocks and streets, under the direction of the proprietors of said town. That it is situated in the south east corner of the south east quarter of the north east quarter of section 34, T. 105 N. R. 14 W. and contains about 14 1/2 acres of ground. Lots are numbered consecutively from 1 to 20 inclusive in block order. - and the size of the lots are marked in small figures in black ink. - The widths of the streets are also marked on the plat in feet. - The position of stone monuments, for future reference and surveys are designated thus: - The streets and lines run east and west are parallel with the quarter section line on the south side. - and the streets and lines run north and south are parallel with the center of Main Street which is also the quarter section line.
