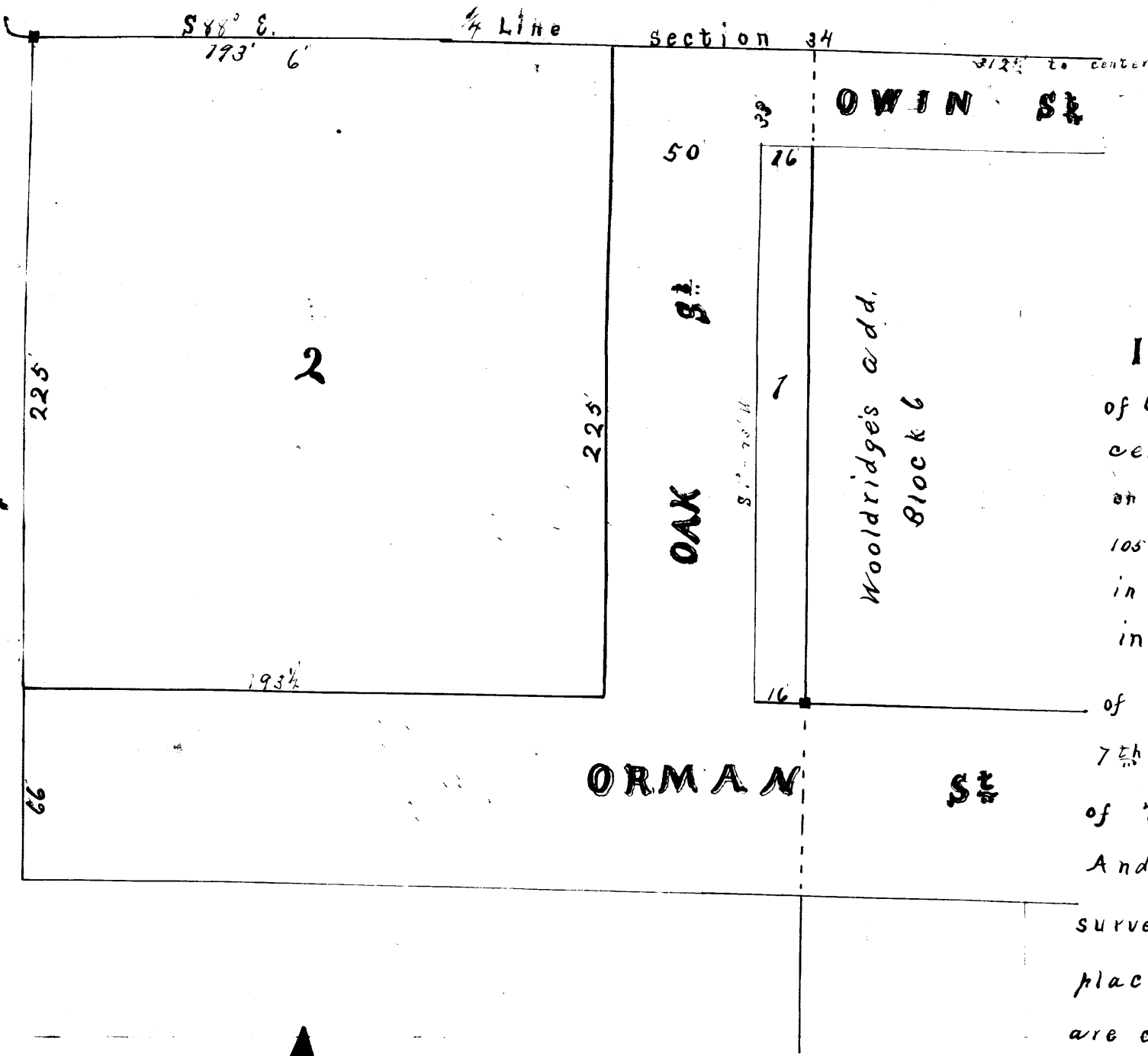



# WOOLDRIDGE'S 2<sup>nd</sup> ADD. TO STEWARTVILLE




