



CERTIFICATE of SURVEYOR.

I, William C. Fraser County Surveyor of the County of Olmsted and State of Minnesota, do hereby certify, that, at the request of "the Minona and South-Western Improvement Co." I did on the 27th day of April A.D. 1895 Survey, Subdivide, stake out and Plat into Blocks and Lots, Streets and Alleys for the purpose of laying out and establishing an Addition to the Town of Stewartville, to be known as "Third South Addition to Stewartville" in the County of Olmsted and State of Minnesota, in the manner indicated on the within plat, a part of the South East quarter of Section No. Thirty four (34), in Township No. One hundred and five (105) North, of Range No. Fourteen (14), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian and situated in the County of Olmsted and State of Minnesota aforesaid.

That the within plat is a true representation of said Survey and Subdivisions, particularly describing and setting forth all the Streets and Alleys, Blocks and Lots in said Addition, giving the names, widths, courses, boundaries and extent of all such streets and Alleys and the dimensions of all such Lots and numbering the same by the Blocks in which they are situated.

I further certify that the "Minona and South-Western Improvement Co." did at the time of laying out said Addition cause to be firmly fixed in the ground, and were so placed under my direction and supervision a stone thirty (30) feet East from the North East corner of Block No. Two (2) and a stone thirty-three (33) feet South from the South West corner of Block No. One (1) in said Addition; that the points where the same may be found are plainly indicated on the within plat, and that said stones were so placed and fixed in the ground as monuments for the guidance of future surveys, and that the boundary lines of the land platted as indicated on said plat are correctly shown thereon.
