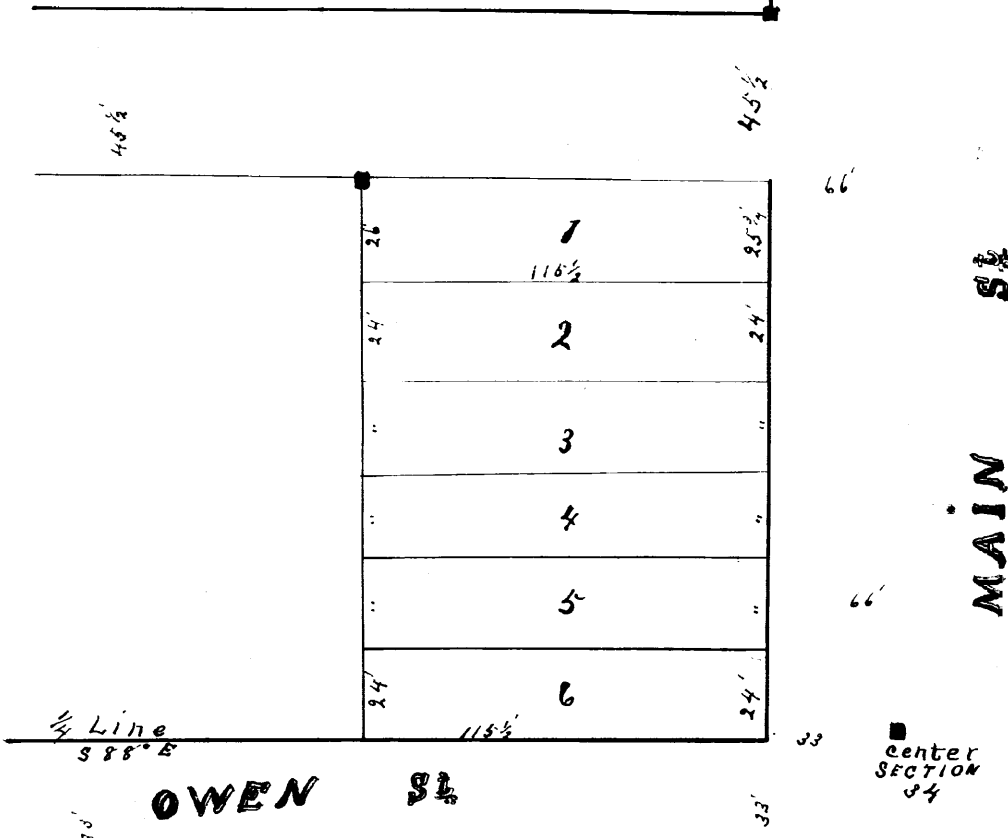
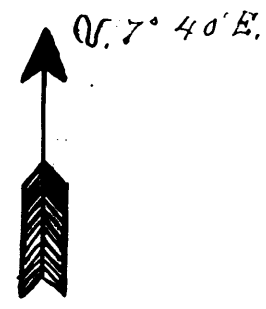

Be it known that school district number 23 of Olmsted County, Minnesota, the owner of Lot 9, Original plat of Stewartville, Olmsted County, Minnesota, the land above platted, did at a special meeting held May 8<sup>th</sup> 1892 which was duly called, due notice thereof having been given, and over five voters being present and voting thereat, and a majority voting therefor, direct the trustees to survey, subdivide, stake out and plat into lots, Lot 9 Original plat of Stewartville, Olmsted County, Minnesota, for the purpose of easier description.

That in pursuance of the aforesaid directions they did on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1892 did cause said Lot 9 to be surveyed, subdivided, staked out and platted into lots as indicated on the above plat
