



MORSE & STEWART'S ADD.
CERTIFICATE of SURVEYOR

I hereby certify that at the request of Chas. N. Stewart I did on the 1-2-3-4 days of June 1892 survey, subdivide, stake out & plat into lots & streets & alleys for the purpose of laying out & establishing an addition to the town of Stewartville, Minn. in the manner indicated on the annexed plat that part of the South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section 34 in Town 105 North, Range 14 West of the 53rd principal Meridian Olmsted County, Minnesota, lying East of the Rail Road,

That the within plat is a true representation of said survey & subdivision, particularly describing & setting forth all the streets & alleys, blocks & lots in said addition, giving the names, widths, courses, boundaries & extent of all such streets & alleys, and the dimension of all such lots and numbering the same by the blocks in which they were situated, Measurements in feet. The location of stone monuments for the guidance of future surveys are indicated on the face of the plat thus - Variation 7 degrees & 40 minutes East, Streets are parallel with the quarter lines,
