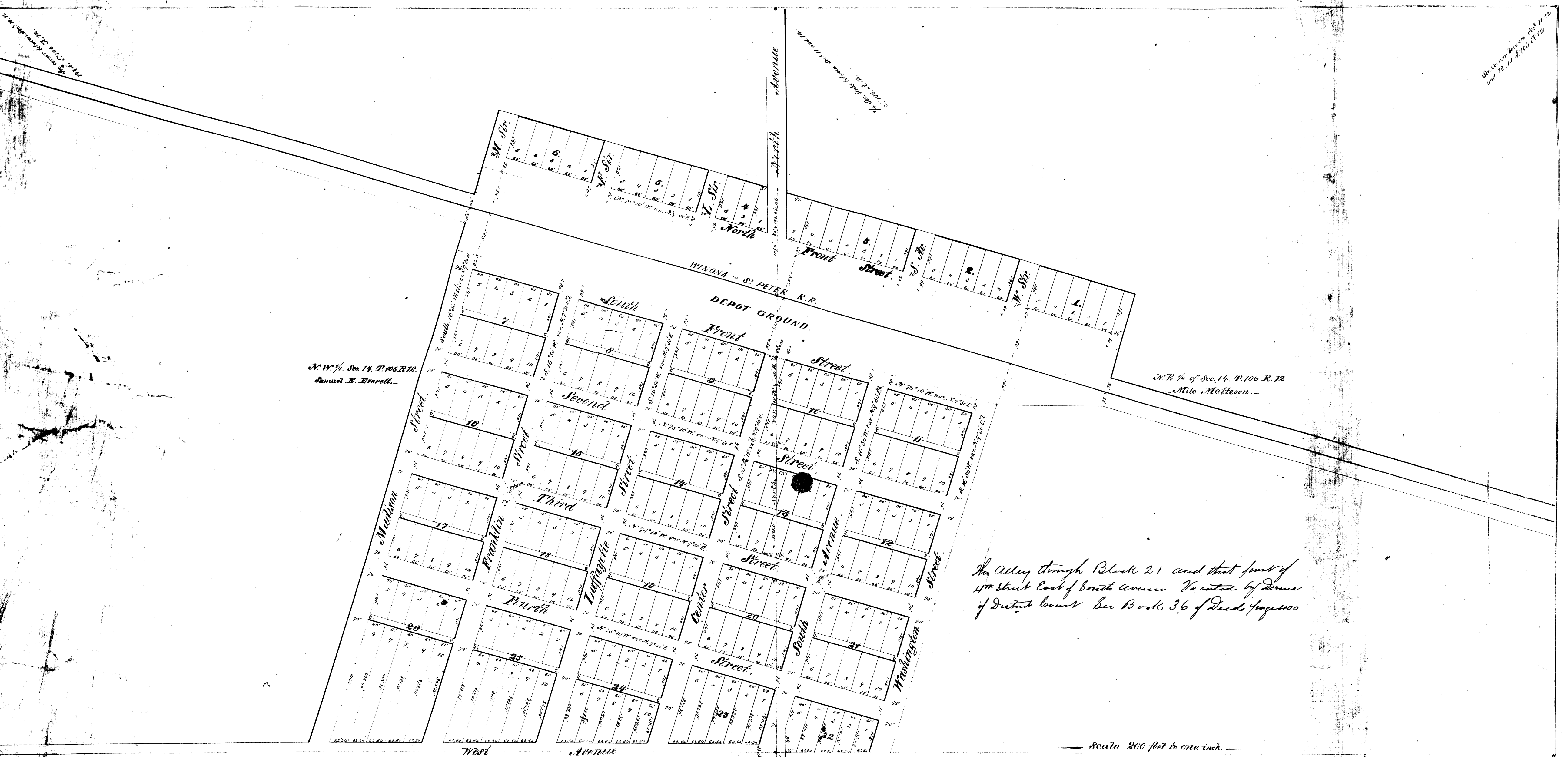

as given therein  
Stones from which future surveys are to be made are placed at the intersections of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and  
South Avenue and 3<sup>rd</sup> and Franklin streets.
