Fraser, County Surveyor in and for the county of Olmsted, State of Minnesota, do hereby certify that I have made an examination of the ground of that part of Section Fourteen, Town one hundred five (105) North, Range fourteen West, Olmsted County Minnesota, described in the annexed Surveyors certificate and plat in compliance with an Act of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota and approved March 7, 1889, entitled, "An Act to insure the accuracy of Town Plats" and that the monuments for the guidance of future surveys as shown on the plat have been correctly placed, that the boundary lines of the land platted are correctly shown on the plat, and that the size of the blocks and lots are as indicated Plat therein. I further certify that at the request of Edward Judge and his wife, I did on the 28th day of September 1896 for the purpose of laying out and establishing the Town of Judge in the manner indicated on the within plat a part of the North West Quarter (1/4) of Section Fourteen, Town one hundred five (105) North, Range fourteen West, Olmsted County, Minnesota, described as follows, to wit, Beginning at a point five hundred fifty three feet East on the Quarter line from South West corner of the Northwest Quarter (1/4) of Section Fourteen, Town one hundred five North, Range fourteen West, Olmsted Co. Minnesota.

Thence East on the said Quarter line three hundred forty six (346) feet, thence North two (2) degrees East seven hundred fifty four feet and one fourth (754 1/4) to a point one hundred fifty feet from the center of the Winona and South Western Railroad, Thence along on a three degree curve to the left South of and parallel with the center of said Railroad to a point six hundred sixteen (616) feet North, Two degrees East of place of beginning, thence south two degrees West six hundred sixteen feet to place of beginning.

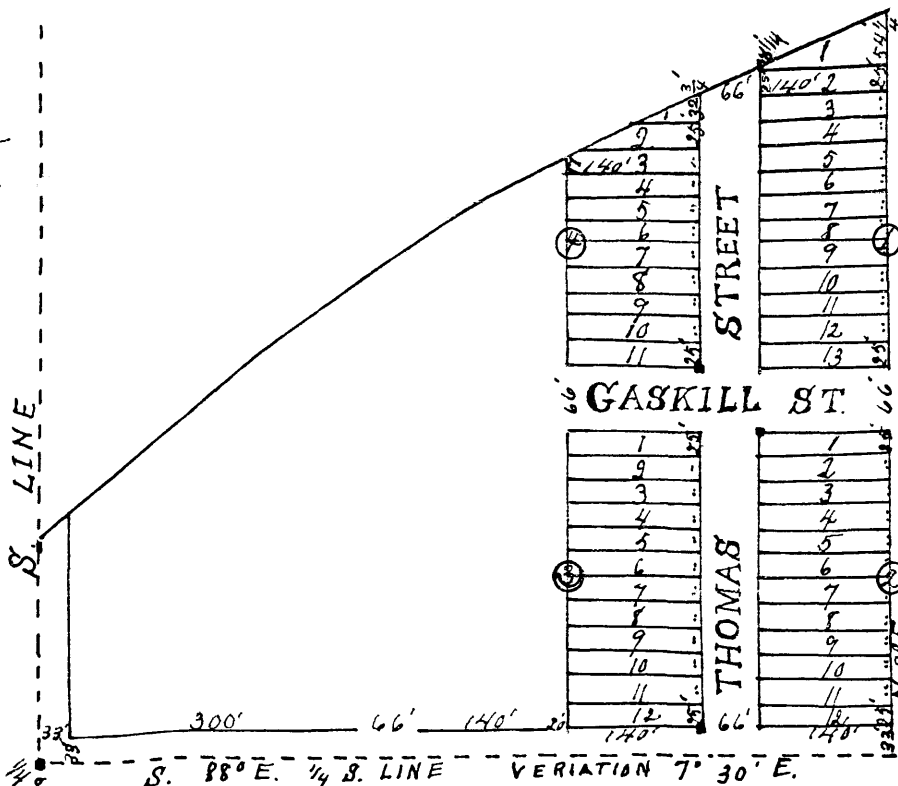
