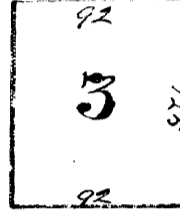
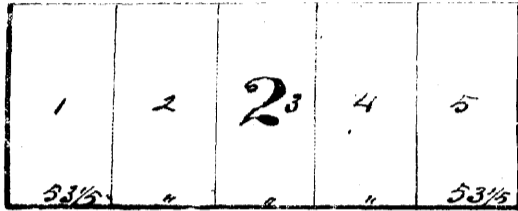


# DOUGLASS.

Line between the towns of Newhaven on the N. and Kalmer on the S.

I hereby certify that the accompanying map is a true delineation of the town of Douglass as laid out to me in the south half of the north west quarter of section 10, 1 in Township No. 10, North, and of Range 15 west, and also the south half of the south west quarter of section 16 in Township No. 10, North, of Range 15 west, under the direction of Harrison Douglas and Daniel Dally, of the County of Lincoln, State of Minnesota. The streets and alleys are 66 feet in width, and all lots are 16 feet in width. The streets and alleys are laid out parallel to or at right angles with the north line of said section, one east of the half road, grounds, the east and west lines run parallel to the north line of said section, one and the north and south lines run parallel with the east line of said north west quarter of section one, without regard to their being at right angles.

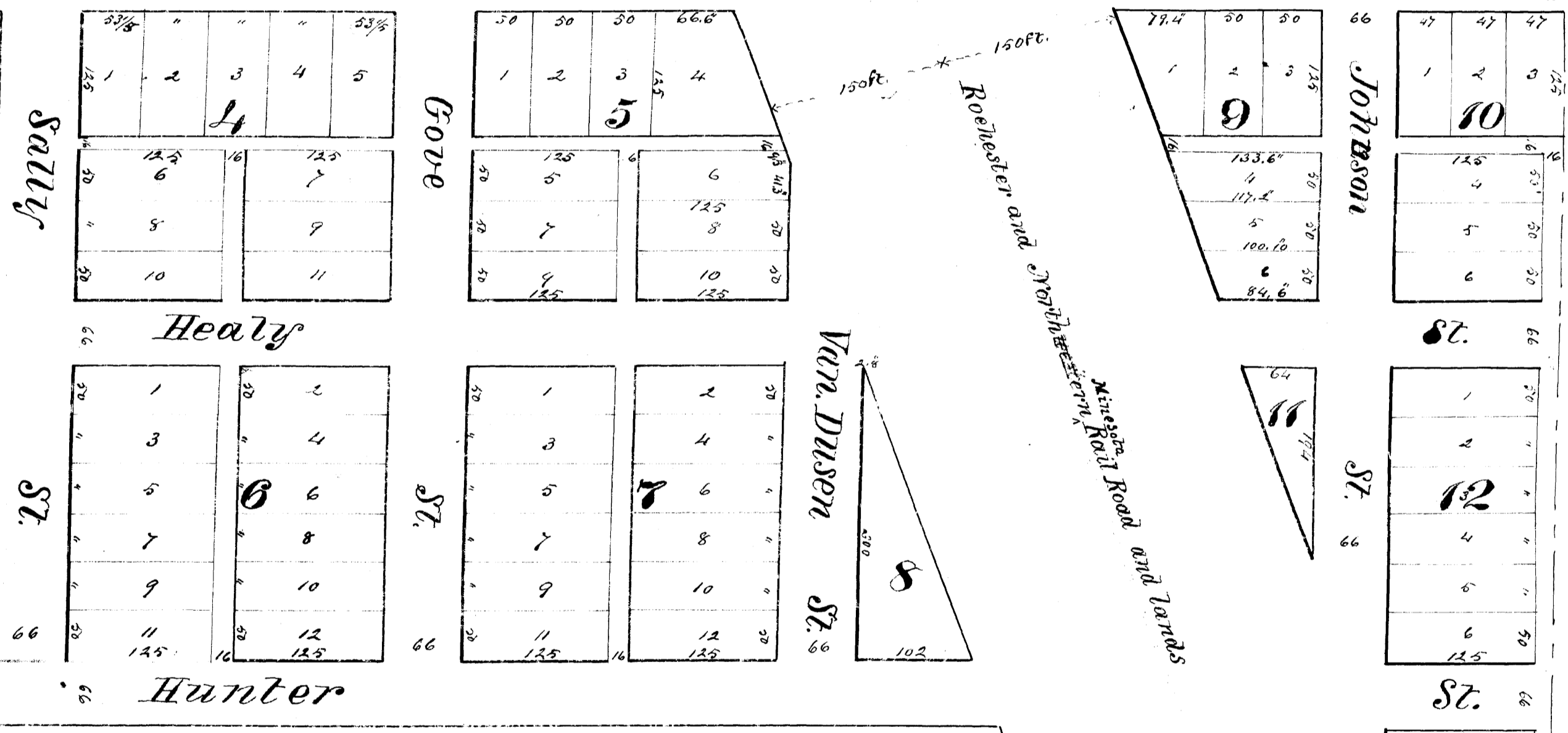
**Explanations**

The size of lots are in small figures in the margins. The numbers of lots are in small figures in the center of each lot respectively. The numbers of blocks are in large figures near the center of each block respectively. The plot is made on a scale of 100 feet to an inch. All distances are in feet and inches and are marked thus in the margin of a lot signifying it of the same dimensions of the lot at the right hand. In a few cases when the end ones only are marked, the intermediates are the same length.
