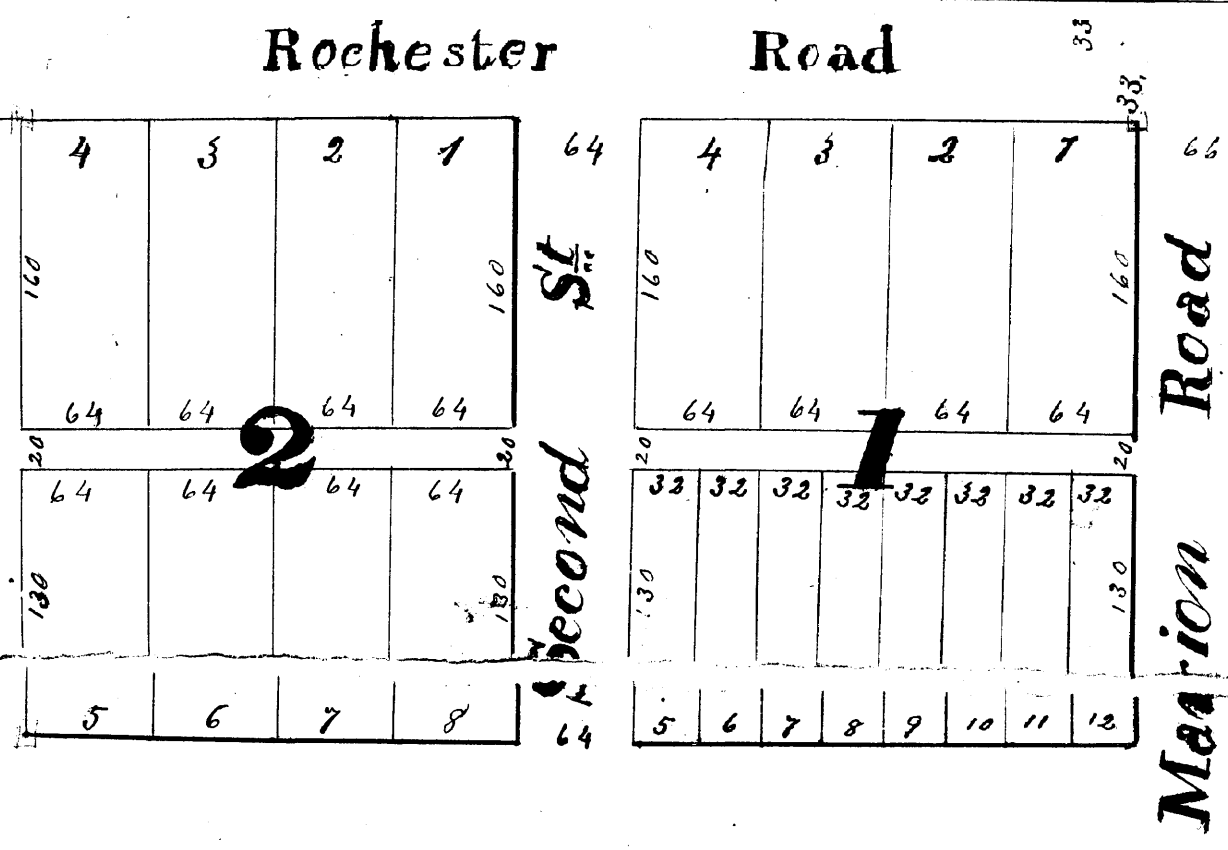
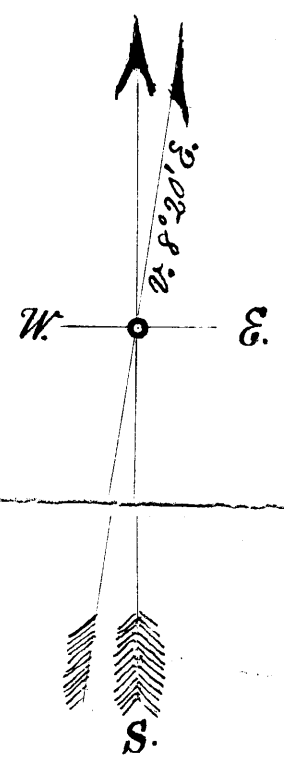


CHESTER.

Explanation: Chester is situated on the North-West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Eleven, Town One Hundred & Six North, of Range Thirteen West. The streets and blocks are laid parallel with and at right angles to, the North line of the N.E. quarter of Section Eleven. The starting point is a stone 1 1/2 x 3 x 2 inches planted in the ground at the N.E. Corner of Block 1, at the intersection of the South line of the Chester & Rochester Road, with the West line of the Chester & Marion Road, and 992 feet East of the quarter section corner between Sections Two & Eleven. A stone is also planted at the N.W. Corner of Block 2. Size of Stone = 3 1/2 x 4 x 4 inches, and two stones, each 2 x 3 x 10 inches are also planted on the North & South sides of a stake at the S.W. Corner of Block 2. The width of the "Rochester" Road, and the "Marion" Road are each 66 feet, Second Street is 64 feet wide, Alleys are each 20 feet wide. The sizes of lots are as marked on the plat on the rear of the lots, and the number of the lots is indicated by figure on the front of lots, The number of the Blocks is indicated by large figures in the center of the blocks.
