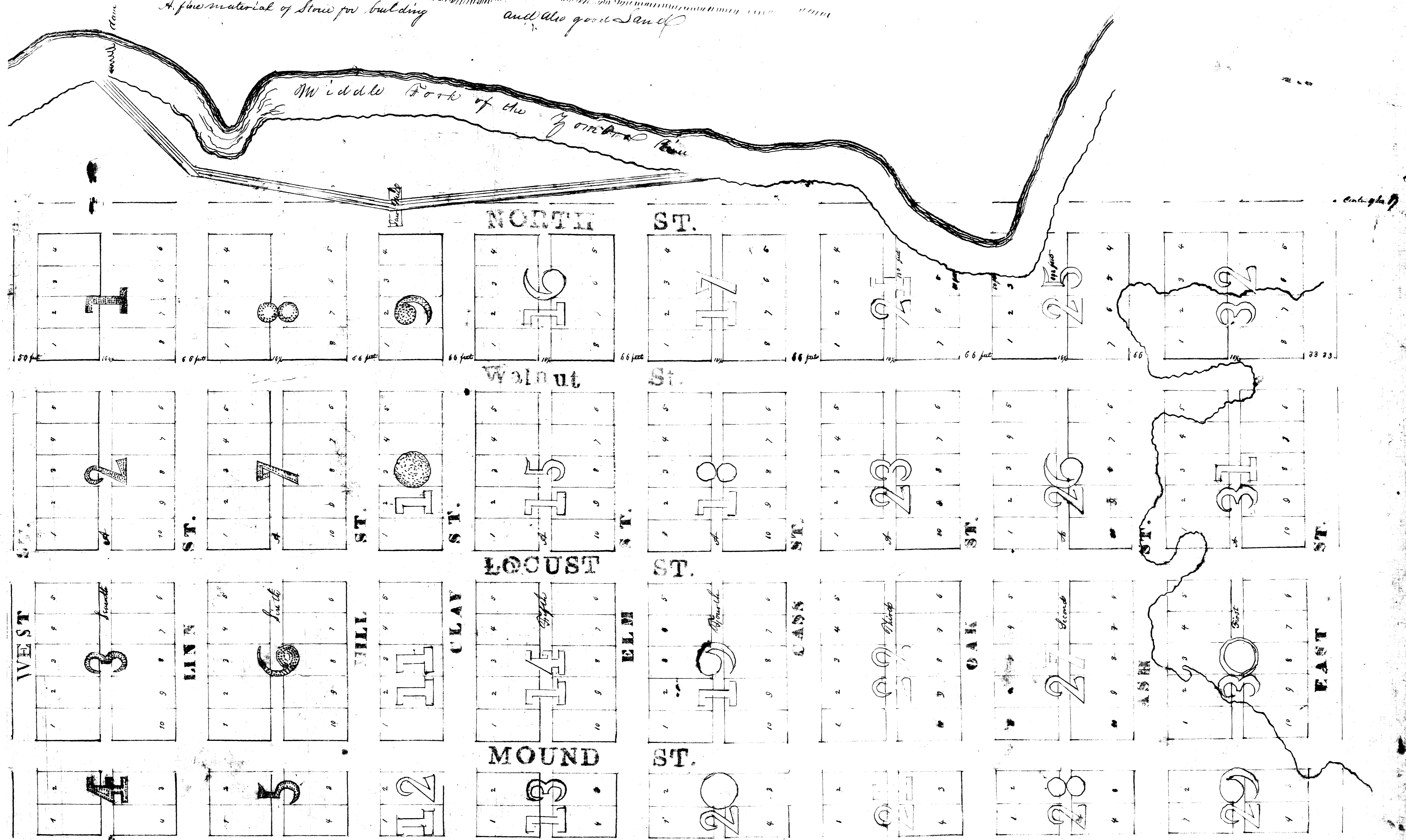
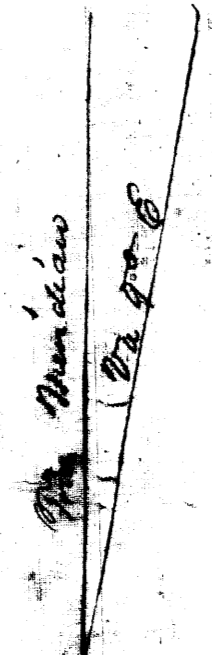


A fine material of stone for building and also good sand
