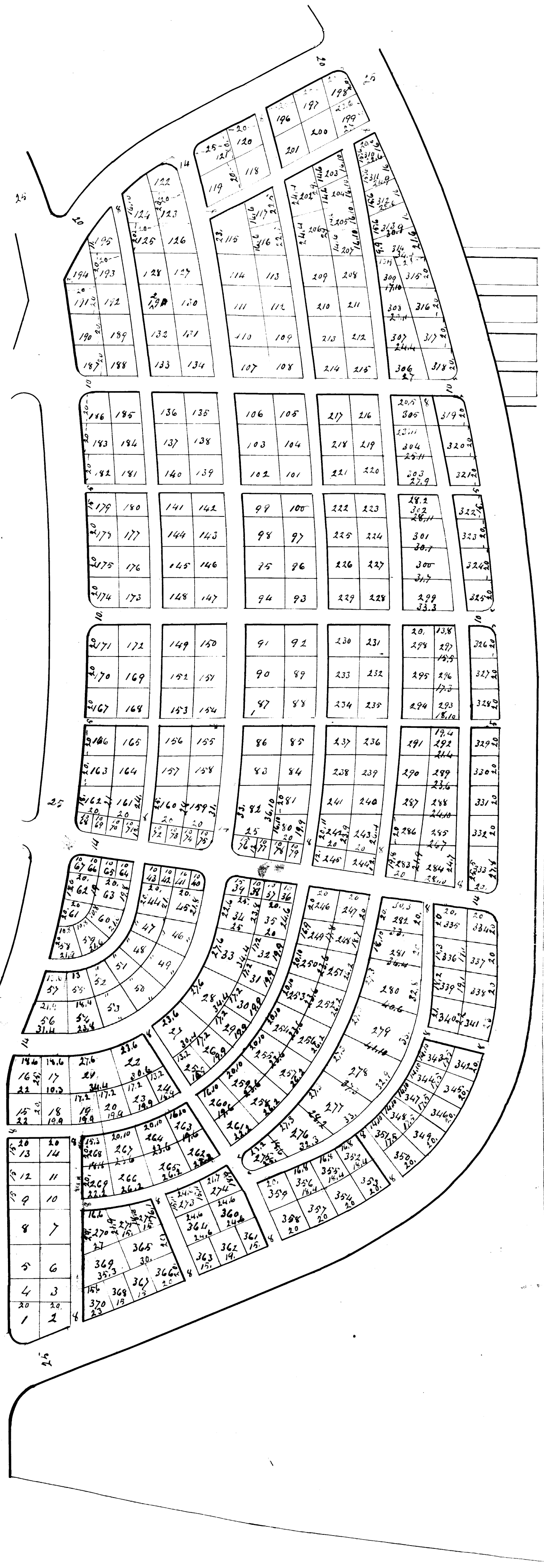


# OAKWOOD CEMETERY SECTION No. 2.



I hereby certify this to be a correct map of that part of Oakwood Cemetery embraced in Section No. 2 together with the avenues approaching and enclosing the same; and that said Section No. 2 is situated on the East side of the lands of the Rochester Cemetery Association, which embrace Lot No. 21 and a strip one hundred feet in width and Eleven hundred and ninety one feet in length north and south extending across the West end of a part of Lot No. 40 and 41, 42 and 43 in the Subdivision of School Section No. 36 Town 107 N. of Range No. 14 W.

The size of lots and the width of avenues and walks are put down in red ink, and the numbers of lots in black ink.
