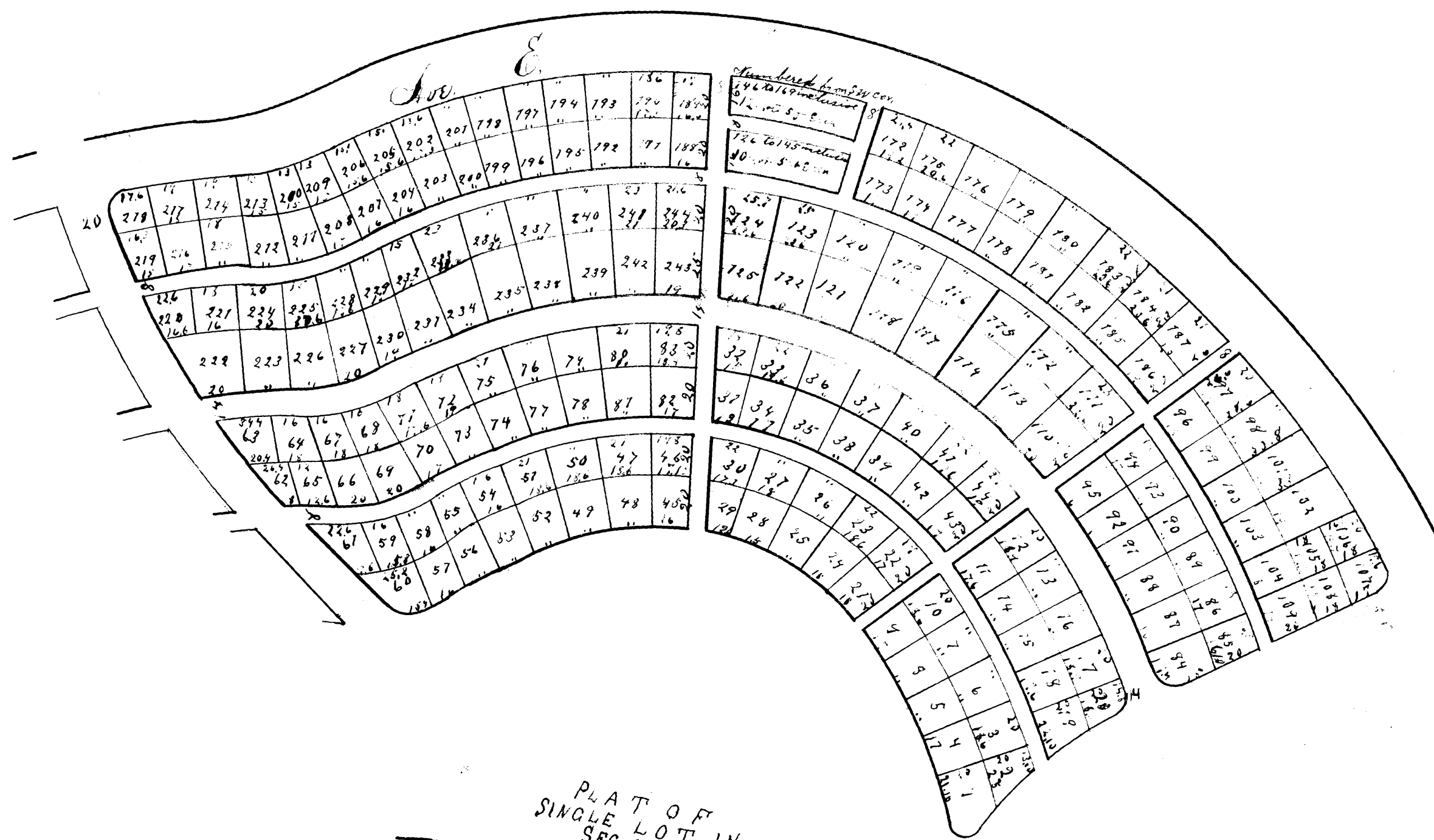


# MAP OF OAKWOOD CEMETERY SECTION No. 4

The size of lots & the width of Avenues, drives and walks are as shewn on the same in feet and inches in black ink and the number of the lots in red ink.

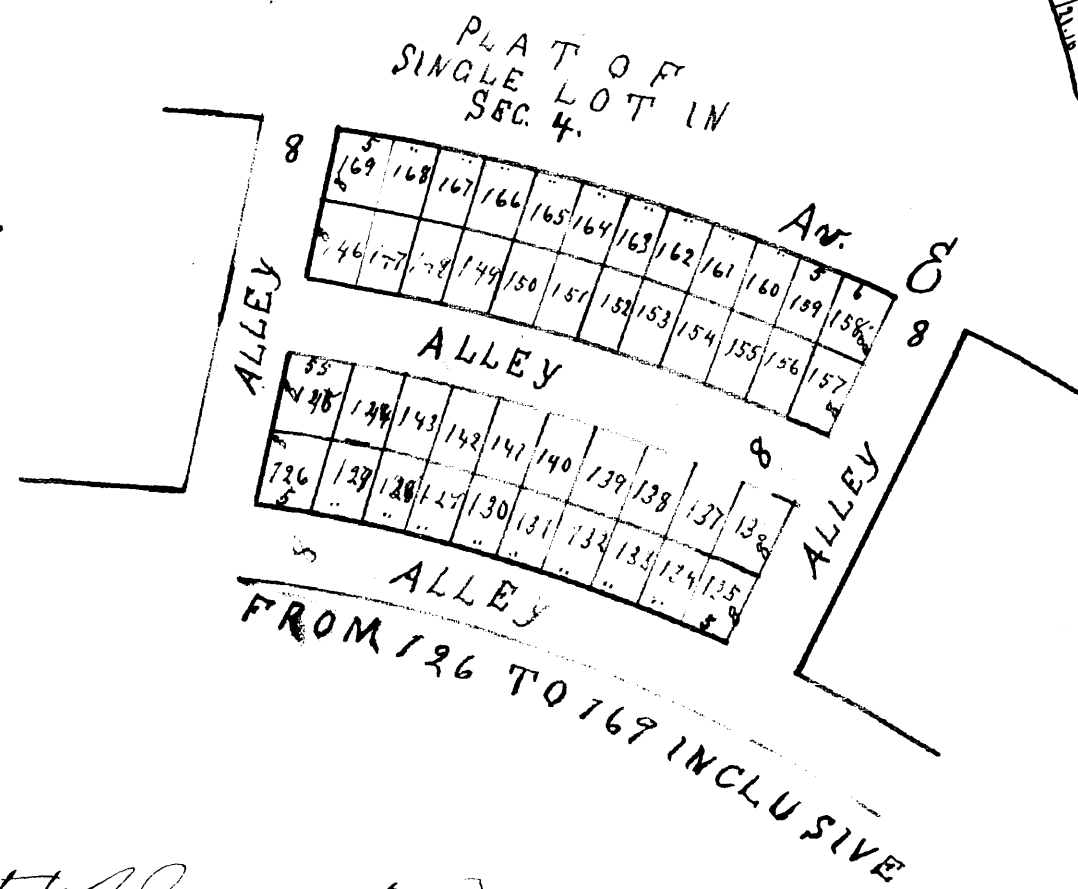
