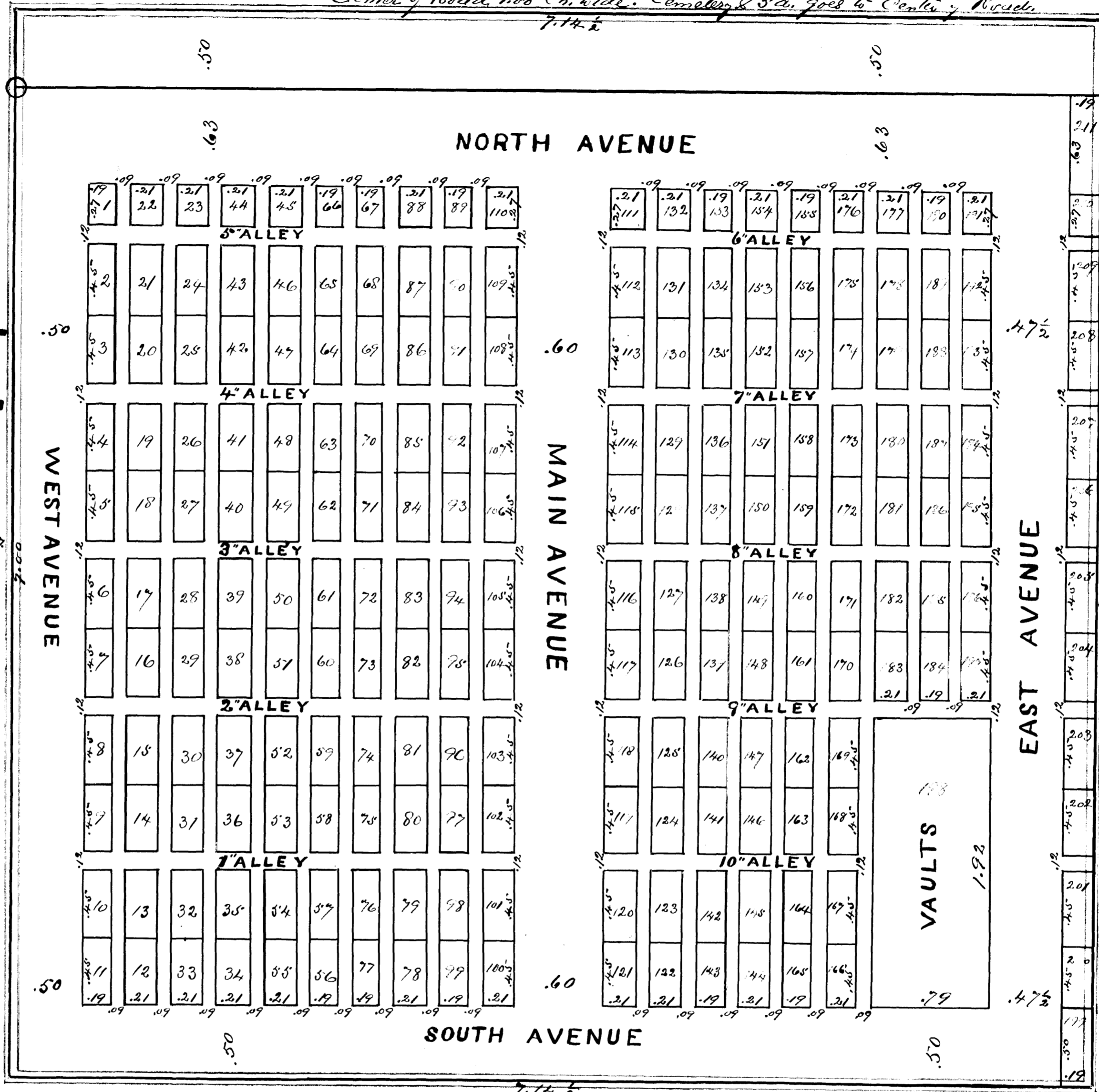


Center of Road, 100 Ch. side. Cemetery S. side goes to Center of Road.

S 4 in of 7° 32' of the N 10' Cor. of Cemetery S 4
post being a Red Cedar 4 in square.
