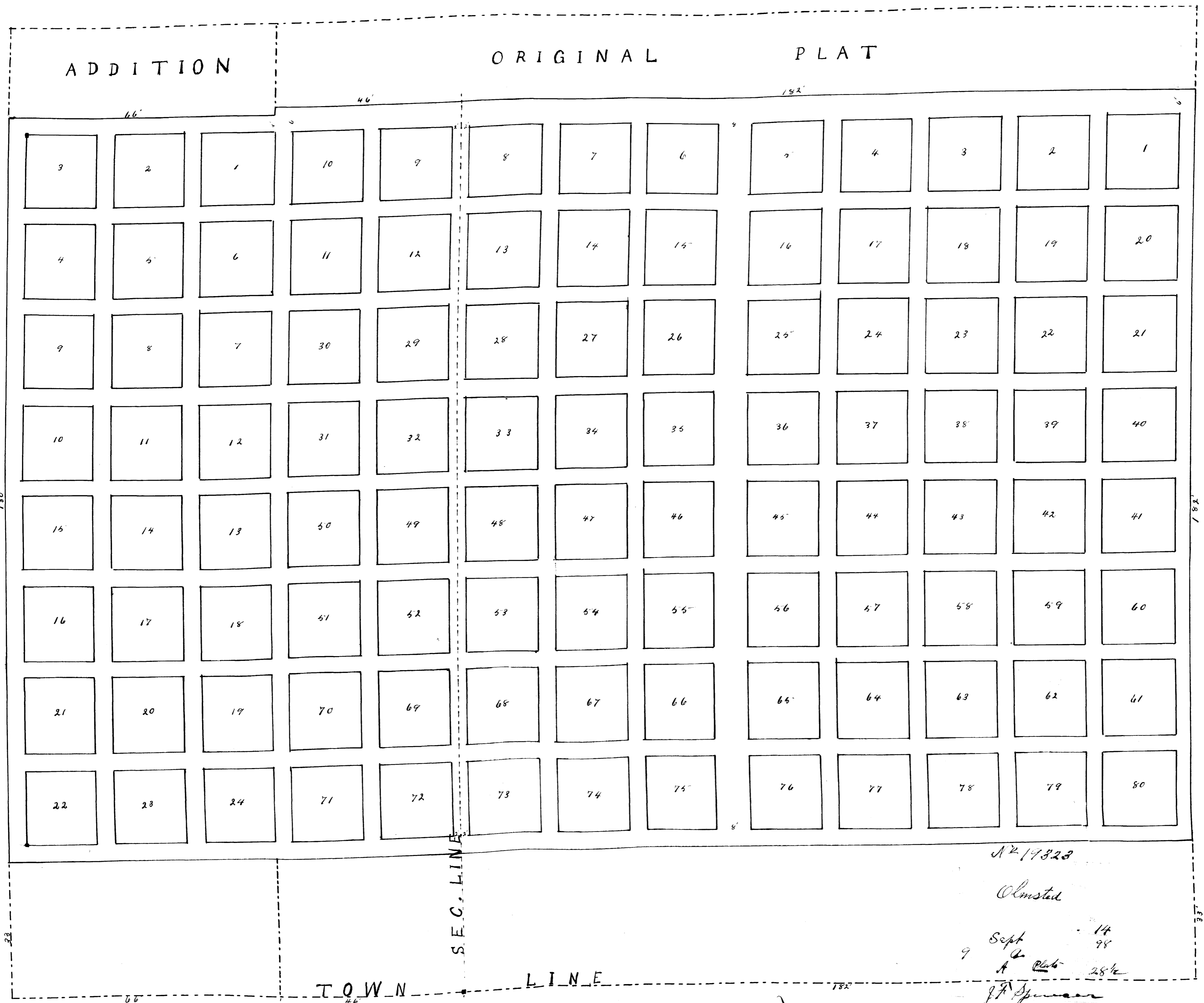

The annexed is a true plat of the Original plat and of the addition as surveyed by me.

The lots are all 14 feet square and the alleys are all 4 feet wide except as otherwise shown on the plat. Stone monuments marked thus -
