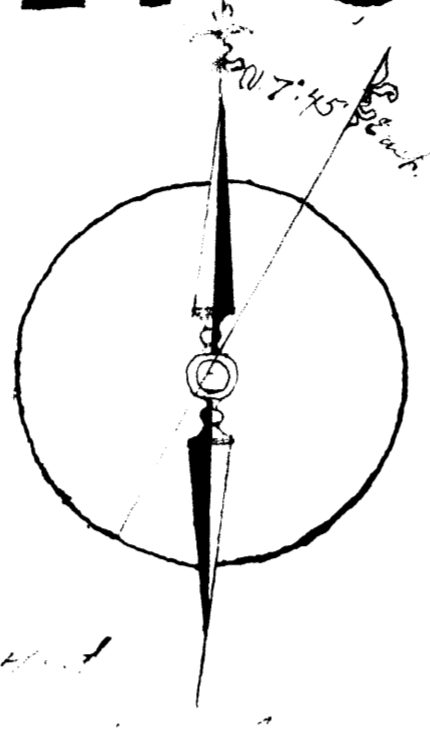


PLAN OF ADD. TO MARIION CEMETERY.



I was called by the Board of Trustees of the Marion Cemetery Association to the Marion Cemetery, under the provisions of the first of the Marion Cemetery Act, to locate the following described plot of land, with commencing at a point of intersection of the line of the North East corner of Block 4, Village of Marion, Grant County, Wisconsin, to the North East corner of the said block, and to run 312 feet, thence due East to a point of intersection of the same line with the line of the Marion Cemetery, with measurement as follows:
