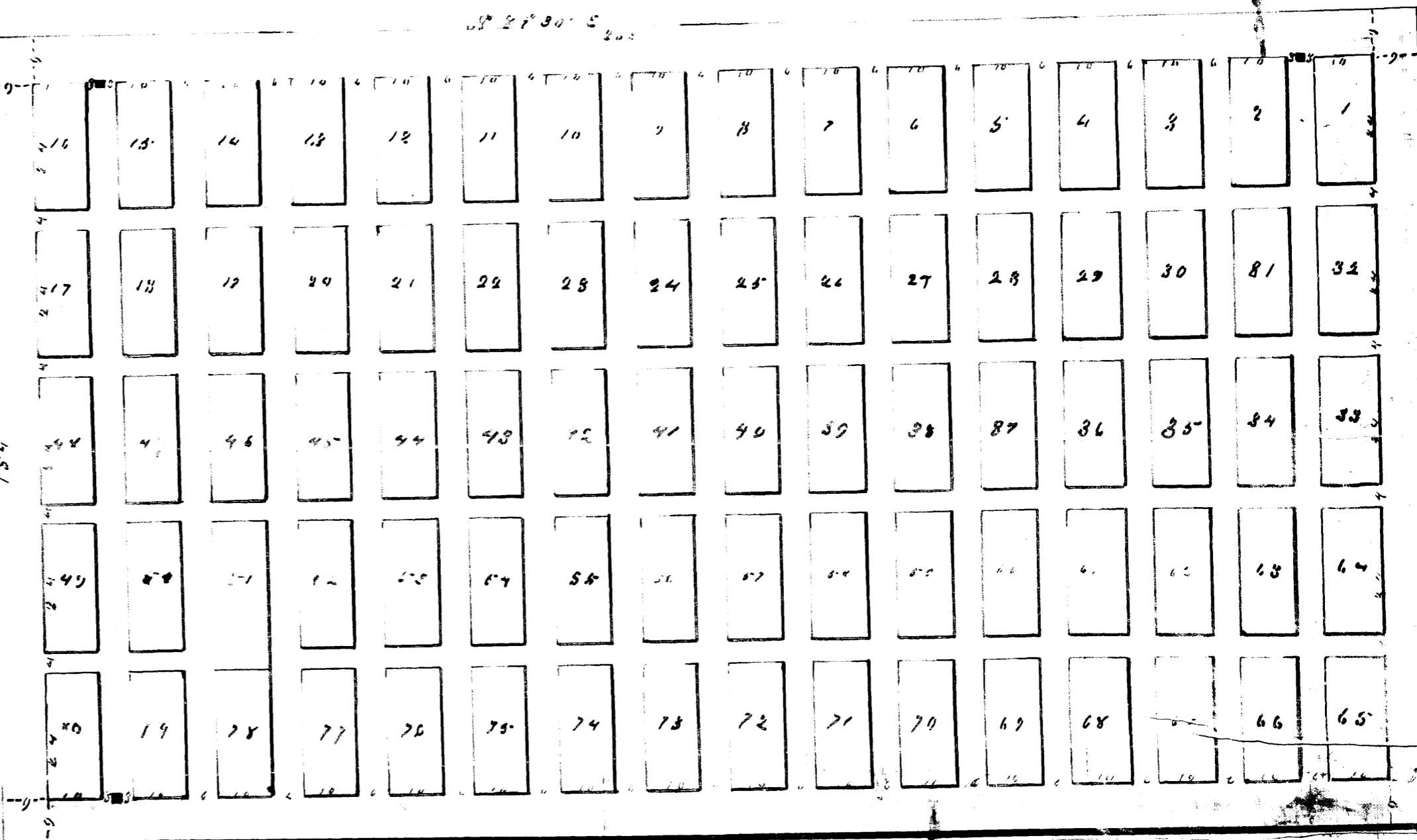

FARMINGTON CEMETERY.

Farmington Cemetery is situated in Section 8 Town 10R Range 13. The initial point of said survey is the North West corner of said section 8, which is N. 88° 20' W. 943 1/2 feet distant from the North West corner of this cemetery. All lines of lots or alleys are either parallel or at right angles to north line which is parallel to, and 33 feet distant from the north line of the section, the course of which is expressed upon the Plat. Position of monuments are indicated upon Plat by small squares. All measurements expressed in feet in figures in black ink. No of feet in red ink in center of lot.
