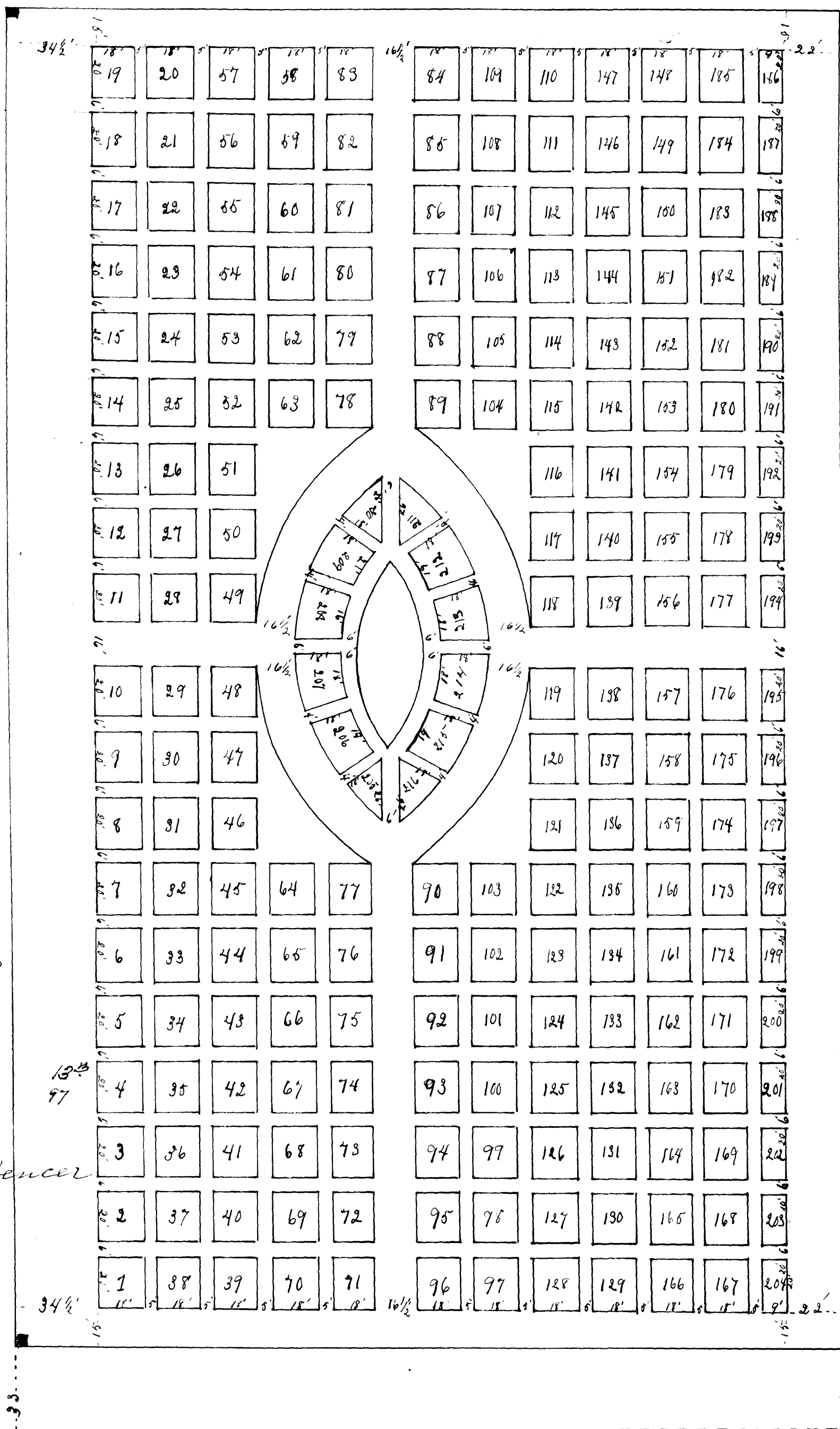


# EVERGREEN CEMETERY

Running thence North thirty two (32) rods, Thence East twenty (20) rods, Thence South thirty two (32) rods, Thence West twenty rods to place of beginning.
