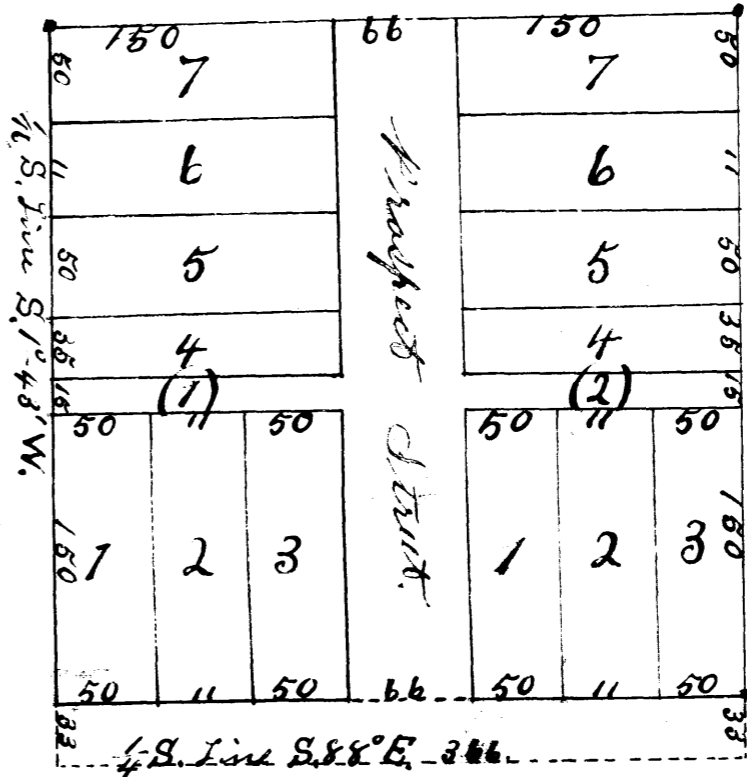


Banner Addition to the Village of Stewartville

I John Fraser County Surveyor in and for Christened County Minnesota do here by certify that I have made an examination of Banner's Addition to the Village of Stewartville, in compliance with an act of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota and approved March 7. th. A. D. 1889, entitled an act to insure the accuracy of town plats, I further certify that the annexed is a correct plat, that the boundary lines are correctly shown; that the monuments for the guidance of future surveys as shown on the plat are correctly placed; that the size of the fractional lots are as shown on the plat. Measurements given in feet as indicated on face of the plat. Dated at Rochester December 31. st. 1894.

I now by certify that at the request of David I. Banner I did on the 27. th day of December 1894 survey subdivided, stake out (with iron stakes and plat) into lots and blocks, streets and alleys for the purpose of laying out and establishing an addition to the village of Stewartville in the manner indicated on the within plat, a piece of corner in the South West corner of the South East Quarter (1/4) of the North East Quarter (1/4) of section number 34, Town 105 North of Range 14 West in the Village of Stewartville, Christened County Minnesota as indicated on the within plat. That the within plat is a true representation of said survey and subdivision, particularly describing and setting forth all the streets, alleys, blocks and lots in said Addition giving the names and the courses, bearings and distances of all such streets and alleys, and dimensions of such blocks and lots. Measurements given in feet as shown on plat. Stone monuments indicated on the face of the plat that are 7-3/4 feet. Witness my hand and seal this 31. st day of December 1894.
