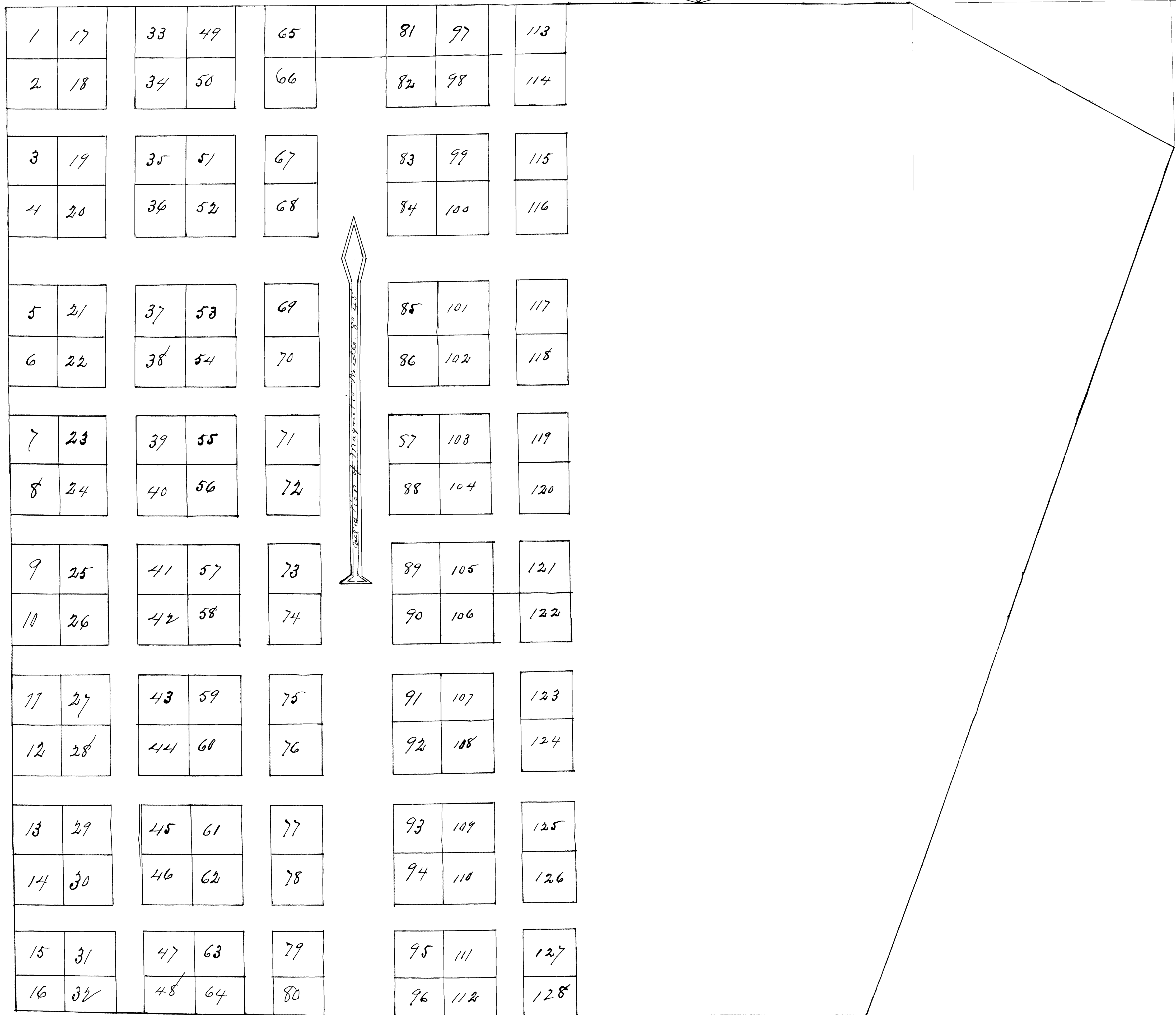


# PLAT OF ORONOCO CEMETRY.



This is to certify that I have re-surveyed and established the old lines and boundaries as near as possible of a certain tract or parcel of land which was laid off into lots streets and alleys as follows. Lots are two rods square alleys eighteen feet wide. Main Street running North and South is forty three feet and six inches wide. The street two blocks South of North side of said tract is two rods wide. The above tract of land, included in boundary lines is described and situated as follows. Commencing on the town road running Northward from the village of Oronoco, to the County line at Trout Branch where said road is intersected by the South boundary of the North East 1/4 of the South West 1/4 of sec. 8 & 108 N. R. 14 West of 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. thence West along Southern boundary of said "Trout" 8.50 chains thence North 10.00 chains thence East 9.00 chains thence South 28° East 3.00 chains thence S. 22° W to the line of above described road. to place of beginning 9.25 chains containing 9 acres more or less.
