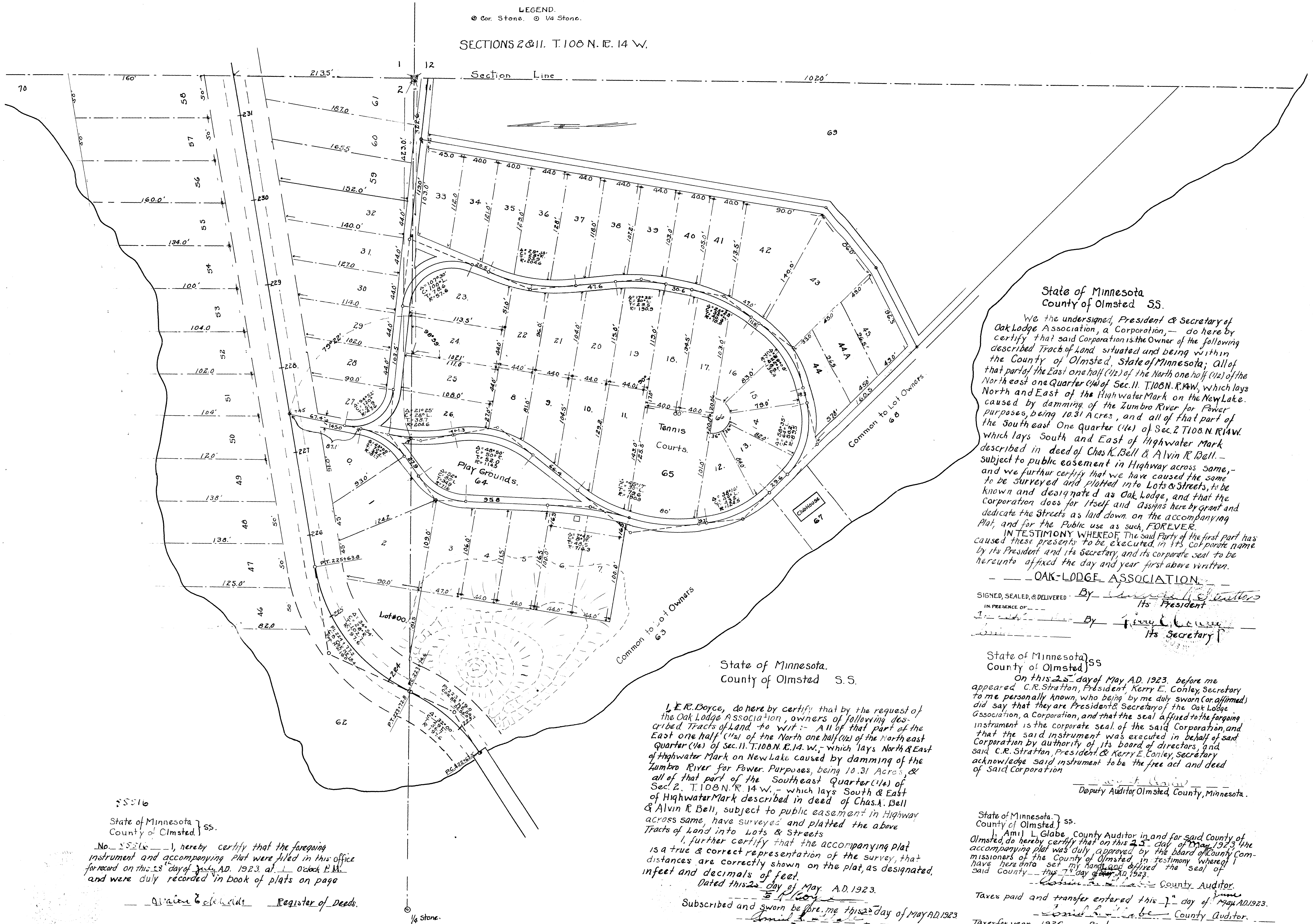


OAK-LODGE

We the undersigned, President & Secretary of Oak Lodge Association, a Corporation, do here by certify that said Corporation is the Owner of the following described Tracts of Land situated and being within the County of Olmsted, State of Minnesota; All of that part of the East one half (1/2) of the North one half (1/2) of the North east one Quarter (1/4) of Sec. 11. T. 108 N. R. 14 W., which lays North and East of the Highwater Mark on the New Lake. caused by damming of the Zumbro River for Power purposes, being 10.31 Acres, and all of that part of the South east One Quarter (1/4) of Sec. 2 T. 108 N. R. 14 W. which lays South and East of Highwater Mark described in deed of Chas. K. Bell & Alvin R. Bell. - subject to public easement in Highway across same, - and we further certify that we have caused the same to be surveyed and platted into Lots & Streets, to be known and designated as Oak Lodge, and that the Corporation does for itself and assigns here by grant and dedicate the Streets as laid down on the accompanying Plat, and for the Public use as such, FOREVER.
