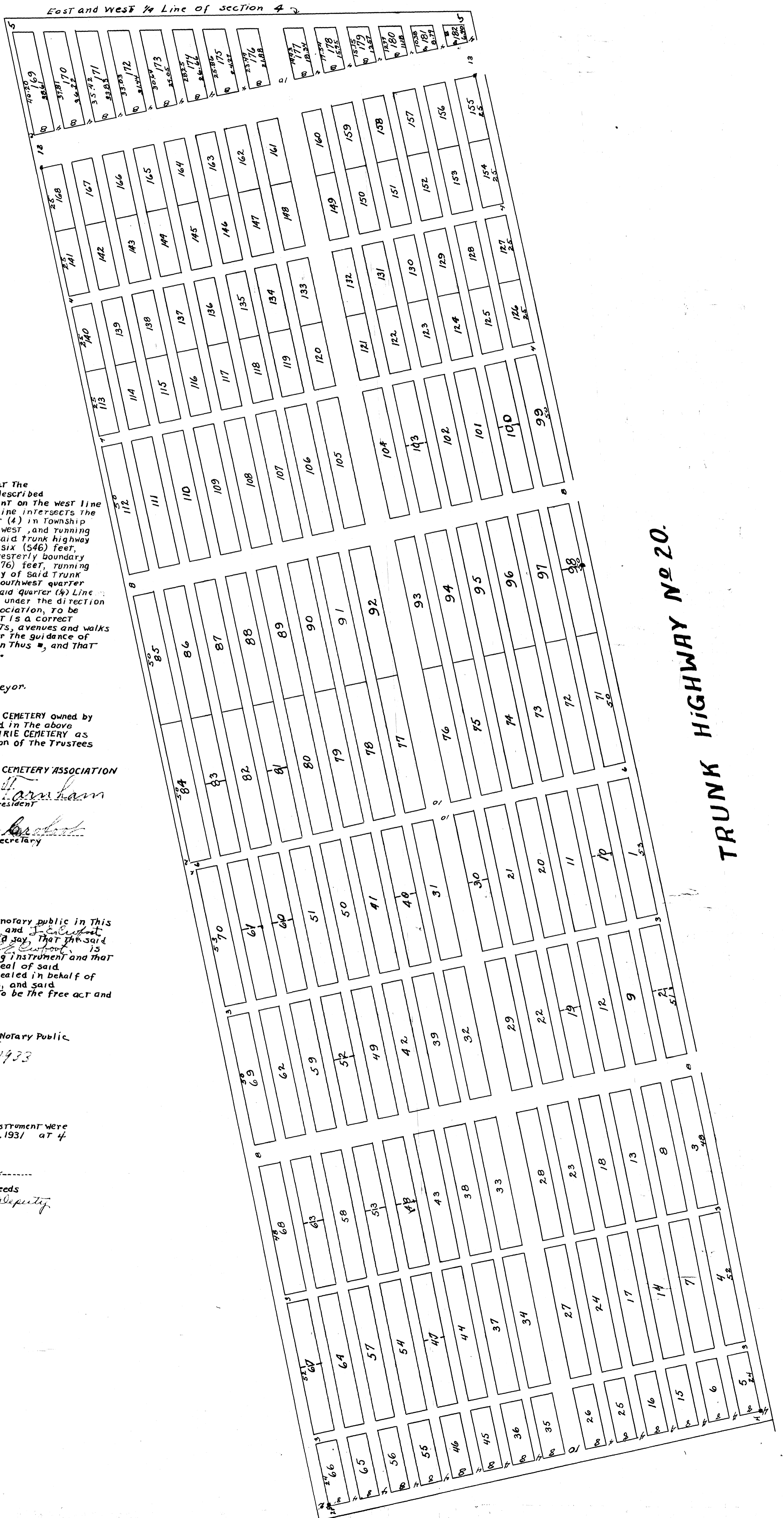
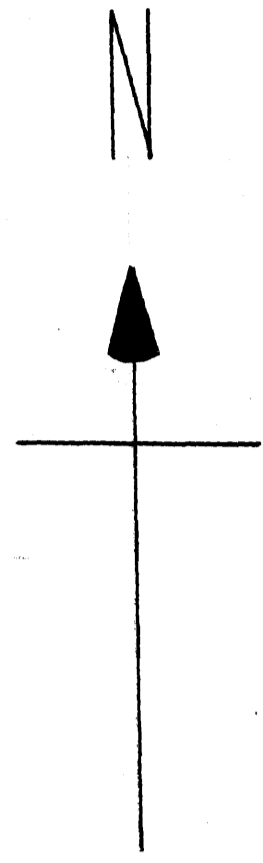



PLEASANT PRAIRIE CEMETERY.

I, John J. Kerr, Surveyor do hereby certify that the accompanying plat is a correct map of the following described land, commencing for a place of beginning at a point on the west line of Trunk Highway number twenty (20) where said west line intersects the east and west quarter (1/4) line of section number four (4) in Township one hundred seven (107) north of range fourteen (14) west, and running thence southeasterly along the westerly boundary of said trunk highway number twenty (20) a distance of five hundred forty six (546) feet, thence southwesterly at right angles to the westerly boundary of said road a distance of one hundred seventy six (176) feet, running thence northwesterly parallel to the westerly boundary of said trunk highway number twenty (20) to the north line of the southwest quarter (1/4) of said section four (4), thence east along the said quarter (1/4) line to place of beginning, as surveyed and laid out by me under the direction of the Trustees of the Pleasant Prairie Cemetery Association, to be known as "THE PLEASANT PRAIRIE CEMETERY" that the plat is a correct representation of the survey; that the size of all lots, avenues and walks are correctly shown on the plat, that the monuments for the guidance of future surveys have been placed in the ground as shown thus , and that the outside boundary lines are designated on the plat.
