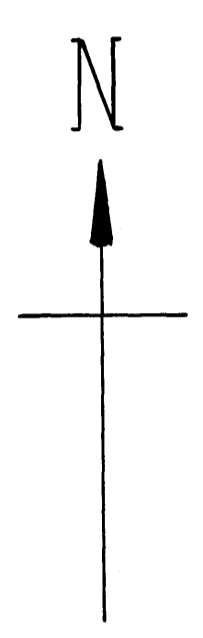
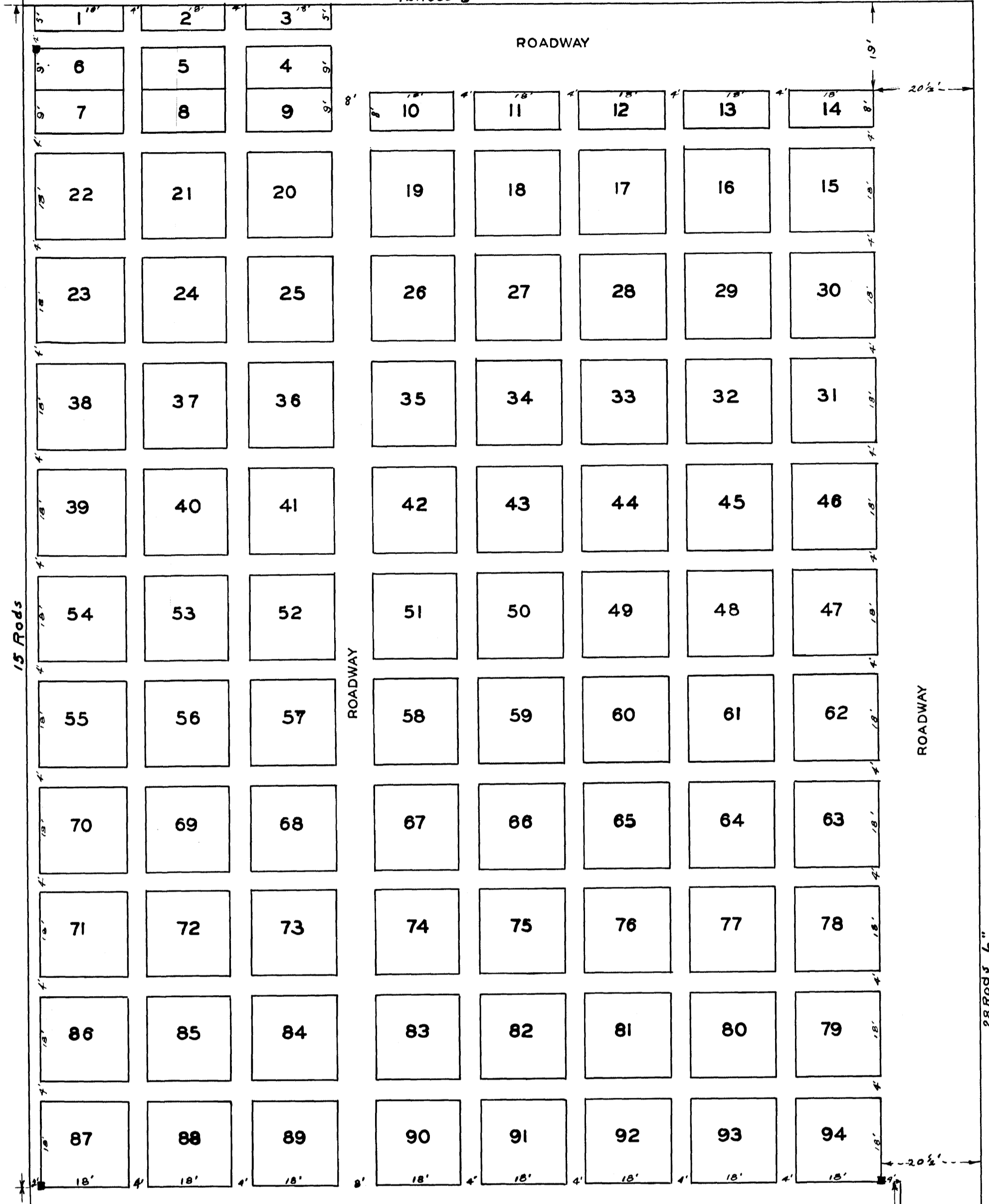


THE THIRD ADDITION TO THE CENTER GROVE CEMETERY.

The foregoing is a map of a portion of the Center Grove Cemetery, Owned by the Center Grove Cemetery Association, situated in the south west quarter (1/4) of Section thirty-six (36) Township No. one hundred eight (108) north of Range fifteen (15) west, in Olmsted County, State of Minnesota as described by the accompanying surveyors certificate to be known as "THE THIRD ADDITION TO THE CENTER GROVE CEMETERY" as surveyed by John J. Kerr, surveyor under the direction of the trustees of said association.

I, John J. Kerr, Surveyor, do hereby certify that the foregoing plat is a correct map of the third addition to the Center Grove Cemetery as surveyed and laid out by me under the direction of the trustees of the Center Grove Cemetery Association to be known as "THE THIRD ADDITION TO THE CENTER GROVE CEMETERY" described as follows
Commencing at a point thirteen (13) rods, six (6) inches north of the southwest corner of section thirty-six (36), Township one hundred eight (108), North of Range fifteen (15) West, in Olmsted County, State of Minnesota, for a place of beginning and running thence north fifteen (15) rods, thence east twelve (12) rods six (6) inches, thence south twenty-eight (28) rods six (6) inches, thence west one (1) rod, thence north thirteen (13) rods six (6) inches, thence west eleven (11) rods six (6) inches to place of beginning; that the plat is a correct representation of the survey, that the size of all lots, avenues and walks are correctly shown on the plat, that monuments for the guidance of future surveys have been placed in the ground as shown, and that the outside boundary lines are designated on the plat.
