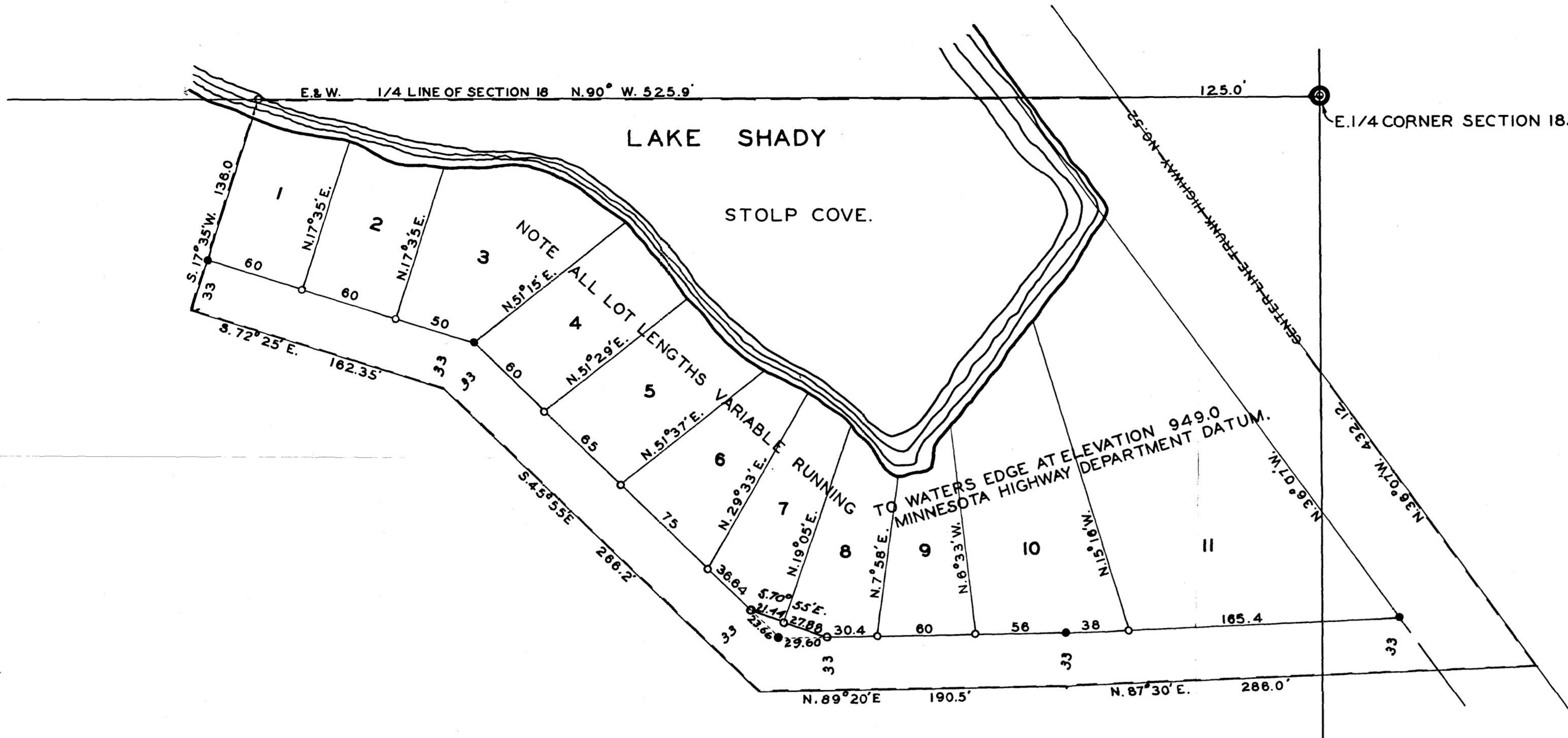


STOLP COVE

I John J. Kerr County Surveyor, do hereby certify, that at the request of Carl F. Stolp and Ida B. Stolp his wife, owners of the real estate in the County of Olmsted, State of Minnesota as hereinafter described to wit: Commencing at the east one quarter (1/4) corner of section number eighteen (18) in township number one hundred eight (108) North of Range fourteen (14) west of the fifth (5th) principal meridian and running thence west along the north line of said southeast one quarter (1/4) one hundred twentyfive (125) feet to the center of Trunk Highway number fifty two (52) for a place of beginning, and running thence west on the north line of said one quarter (1/4) section five hundred twentyfive and nine tenths (525.9) feet, thence south seventeen degrees thirty five minutes (17°35') west one hundred thirty six (136) feet, thence south fortyfive degrees fifty five minutes (45°55') east, two hundred sixty six and two tenths (266.2) feet, thence North eighty nine degrees and twenty minutes (89°20') east one hundred ninety and five tenths (190.5) feet, thence North eighty seven degrees thirty minutes (87°30') east two hundred eighty six (286) feet to the center of Trunk Highway fifty two (52), thence North thirty six degrees seven minutes (36°7') west four hundred thirtytwo and twelve one hundredths (432.12) feet to place of beginning, excepting that portion of the above described lands which are overflowed by the waters of Lake Shady when the water in the lake is level with the crest of the dam at elevation nine hundred forty nine (949) feet Minnesota Highway Department datum, I have surveyed, staked, and platted the said real estate into lots and streets as shown by the plat on which this certificate is written and which shall be known and designated as "STOLP COVE". I further certify that the plat is a correct representation of such survey, that all distances are correctly shown on the plat as designated in feet and decimals of feet; that the outside boundaries are correctly designated on the plat; that there are no wet lands except as shown; that no part of said tract of land has been heretofore platted; and that monuments for the guidance of future surveys have been placed in the ground at the places designated thus.
