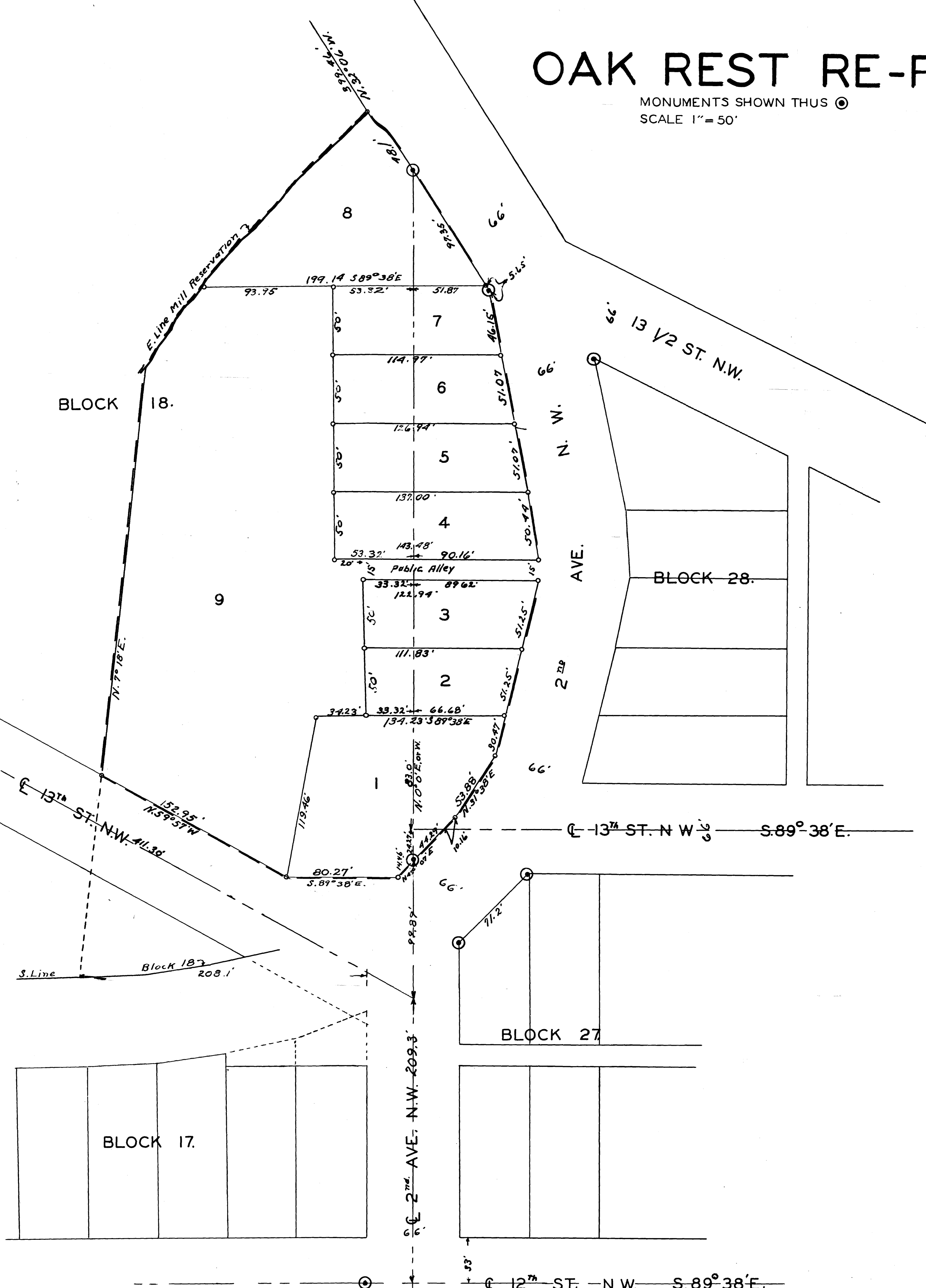


OAK REST RE-PLAT.

Surveyor's Certificate.

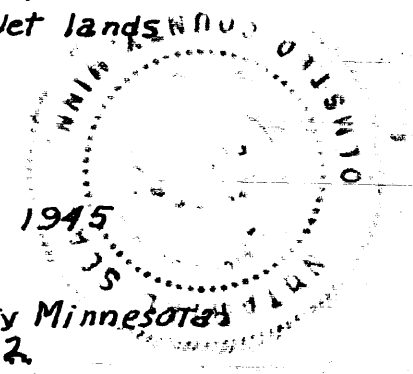

Kerr, County Surveyor in and for said County do hereby certify that at the request of Edith Cagley (widow), owner of the following described lands in Olmsted County Minnesota To-wit: All that part of lots one (1) and two (2) in Block eighteen (18) Northern Addition to the City of Rochester, which lies north of Thirteenth Street, northwest as laid out through over and across the said block eighteen (18) and east of the following described line, Commencing at a point on the South line of Block eighteen (18) in Northern Addition two hundred eight and one tenth (208.1) feet west of the west line of Second (2nd) Avenue Northwest and running thence north seven (7) degrees eighteen (18) minutes east across said lots one (1) and two (2) of block eighteen (18) to the east line of the Mill reservation, running thence northerly along the east line of said mill reservation to the northerly line of said block eighteen (18) I have surveyed, Staked and platted the above described lands into lots, streets and alleys such subdivision to be known and designated as "OAK REST RE-PLAT". I further certify that the accompanying plat is a true and correct representation of said survey as made, that the distances are correctly shown in feet and decimals of a foot, that the measurements on lines which may be curved are Chord measurements that the outside boundaries are correctly shown on the plat, that monuments for the guidance of future surveys have been placed in the ground at the locations marked thus ⊙, and that there are no wet lands thereon.
